The instant Original Application has been filed under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 for the following reliefs :-<ol style="list-style-type: none">A. <i>To issue/pass an order to set-aside quash the letter/order dated 24 April 2020 passed by respondents no. 3, which is annexed as Annexure No. 1 to this Original Application.</i>B. <i>To issue/pass the direction and order to the respondents to Grant disability element of disability pension @15% deemed to be 20% for life from date of SOS i.e. 01.04.2020 (Date of Discharge 31.03.2020) along with 12% interest on arrear in light of Hon'ble Apex Court Judgments.</i>C. <i>To issue/pass an order or directions to the respondents to Grant benefit of broad-banding/rounding off disability pension to the tune of @50% for life from date of SOS i.e. 01.04.2020 (Date of Discharge 31.03.2020) along with 12% interest on arrear in light of Hon'ble Apex Court Judgments and Government letter dated 31.01.2001.</i>D. <i>To issue/pass an order or directions to the respondents to constitute a fresh Re-Survey Medical Board to assess the present medical condition of applicant as per Para 16 of Amendment to Chapter VI & VII Guide to Medical Officers (Military Pensions), Ministry of Defence, 2008 and accordingly grant disability element of disability pension to the applicant.</i>E. <i>To issue/pass any other order or direction as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem just, fit and proper under the circumstances of the case in</i>

favour of the applicant.

F. To allow this Original Application with costs.

4. Briefly stated facts of the case are that the applicant was enrolled in the Indian Army on 29.03.2003 and discharged from service on 31.03.2020 in Low Medical Category on completion of fulfilling the conditions of his enrolment under Rule 13(3) Item III (i) of the Army Rules, 1954. At the time of discharge from service, the Release Medical Board (RMB) held at Military Hospital, Gwalior on 28.10.2019 assessed his disability '**PRIMARY HYPOTHYROIDISM (E-03)**' @ 15 % for life as **aggravated by service**. The applicant's claim for grant of disability element of disability pension was rejected vide letter dated 24.04.2020. The applicant preferred Appeal dated 13.03.2022 but of no avail. It is in this perspective that the applicant has preferred the present Original Application.

5. Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that the Categorisation Medical Board held on 26.09.2018 assessed the applicant's disability @20% but the RMB held on 28.10.2019, without any justification, has reduced the applicant's disability @15% for life. He relying upon Para 16 of Chapter VII of Amendment to Chapter VI & VII Guide to Medical Officers (Military Pensions), 2008 prays for issuing direction to the respondents to hold Re-Assessment of applicant's disability by holding Re-Survey Medical Board (RSMB).

6. Per contra, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that although the applicant's disability has been regarded as aggravated by service by the RMB but since the degree of disability has been assessed @15% for life, which is less than 20%, the applicant is not entitled for the grant of disability element of disability pension in terms of Regulation 53 (a) of the Pension Regulations for the Army, 2008 (Part-I) which provides that "*An individual released/retired/discharged on completion of terms of engagement or on completion of service limits or on attaining the prescribed age (irrespective of his period of engagement), if found suffering from a disability attributable to or aggravated by military service and so recorded by Release Medical Board, may be granted disability element in addition to service pension or service gratuity from the date of retirement/discharge, if the accepted degree of disability is assessed at 20% or more*". She further submitted that since the applicant's disability has been assessed @15% for life, the applicant is not entitled for holding RSMB.

7. Para 16 of Chapter VII of Amendment to Chapter VI & VII Guide to Medical Officers (Military Pensions), 2008 reads as under :-

"16. Reassessment of Disability. There will be no periodical reviews by the Resurvey Medical Boards for re-assessment of disabilities. In case of disabilities adjudicated as being of a permanent nature, the decision once arrived at will be final unless the individual himself requests for a review. In cases of disabilities which are not of a permanent nature, there will be only one review of the percentage by a Medical Board to be

carried out later within a specified time frame. The percentage of disability assessed/recommended by the Board will be final unless the individual himself asks for a review. The review will be carried out by Review Medical Board constituted by DGAFMS.”

8. Upon hearing submission of Ld. Counsel of both the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case specially the provisions contained in Para 16 of Guide to Medical Officer (Military Pensions), 2008, we **dispose of** the Original Application finally with the direction to the respondents to conduct Re-Survey Medical Board (RSMB) of the applicant to assess his disability for deciding entitlement of disability element of disability pension.
