Copy of the RMB was not issued to the applicant which he obtained through RTI. The applicant has preferred appeal cum legal notice dated 16.12.2023 to the respondents for grant of disability element which is still pending.</p> <p>6. Ld. counsel for the applicant further submitted that the instant O.A. may be disposed of at this stage by directing the respondents to decide the representation/Appeal preferred by the applicant and ends of justice would be served if a direction is given by this Tribunal to the respondents/competent authority to consider and dispose of the pending representation dated 16.12.2023 of the applicant attached as Annexure A-1 to this O.A. by way of reasoned and speaking order within a stipulated period of time.</p> |

7. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the submission of the applicant's counsel to decide the appeal of the applicant.
8. In view of the above innocuous prayer of the applicant, respondents/competent authority is directed to consider and decide the representation/appeal dated 16.12.2023 of the applicant (Annexure A-1) and pass a reasoned and speaking order according to law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, under intimation forthwith to the applicant.
9. It is made clear that nothing has been commented upon the merits of the case.
10. Applicant shall be at liberty to approach proper forum if he is not satisfied with the decision of the respondents passed on his representation/appeal.
