Counsel for the applicants is present.</div></div><div><div>2.</div><div>Heard the Id. counsel for the applicants and perused the records.</div></div><div><div>3.</div><div>This Application has been filed under Section 31 of Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 against the judgment and order dated 29.3.2023 passed in Original Application No.321 of 2019.</div></div><div><div>4.</div><div>There is delay of 01 year, 05 months and 11 days in filing of Leave to Appeal.</div></div><div><div>5.</div><div>Submission of learned counsel for the applicants is that the delay in filing Leave to Appeal is neither deliberate nor intentional, but it is bonafide. He further submits that some delay has occurred in obtaining the approval of the competent authority for filing Leave to Appeal before this Tribunal. As such, a prayer has been made to condone the delay in filing Leave to Appeal.</div></div><div><div>6.</div><div>Having considered the submissions as advanced by the learned counsel for the applicants, we are of the considered view that the explanation as offered by the applicants for delay in filing Leave to Appeal is not convincing. It is trite law that if time limit is provided for filing of any application; then the same must be filed within the stipulated period of time and the delay, if any, should be explained on day-to-day basis, which in the case, in hand, is lacking.</div></div><div><div>7.</div><div>In view of the above, we are not inclined to condone the delay in filing Leave to Appeal.</div></div><div><div>8.</div><div>Accordingly, delay condonation application is dismissed.</div></div><div><div>9.</div><div>Consequently, Leave to Appeal is also dismissed being barred by limitation.</div></div><div><div>(Lt.
