Original Application is not maintainable in this Tribunal and it is liable to be dismissed.

- 6. In view of the aforesaid, we do not find any good reason to by-pass the statutory alternate remedy provided under the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. The instant Original Application is not maintainable and cannot be admitted for hearing.
- 7. Accordingly, without entering into the merit of the case, the application is **dismissed** on the ground of statutory alternative remedy available to him leaving it open to the applicant to file an appeal before the appropriate authority in accordance with the provisions of the <u>Armed Forces Tribunal Act</u>, 2007.
- 8. No order as to costs.
- 9. All pending Misc Applications are also disposed off.
