8. Ld. Counsel for the applicant further submits that the applicant is permanent resident of District – Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala but he was residing in Sector-75, Noida, U.P. before filing of this O.A and now the applicant has shifted his residence at Flat No. CS-1/1405, Sector-74, Super Tech Capetown, Noida, U.P which is well within the territorial jurisdiction of this Tribunal. In support of his averment, applicant's counsel has filed copy of the Adhar Card of the applicant through supplementary affidavit showing the address of the applicant at Noida, U.P.
9. We have considered the submissions of Ld. Counsel for the parties and we find that the cause shown for the delay is sufficient. Further being pensionary matter and in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Union of India and Others Vs. Tarsem Singh (2008 (8) SCC 646)**, delay is condoned. Delay condonation application stands disposed of.
10. Objections raised by the respondents with regard to maintainability are also set aside.
