6. We have considered the submissions of Ld. Counsel for the parties and we find that the cause shown for the delay is sufficient. Further, being pensionary matter and in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex court in the case of ***Union of India and others Versus Tarsem Singh*** [2008 (8) SCC 648], delay is **condoned**. Delay condonation application stands disposed off accordingly.
