Thereafter, relevant papers, in ordinary course, ought to have been sent to the PCDA(P), Allahabad for passing appropriate order and the order by the Pension Sanctioning Authority would have been passed on the basis of Re-survey Medical Board proceedings, but the said order has not been challenged by the applicant. It has also not been disclosed as to whether the applicant has preferred first/second appeal against the said order. In spite of it, the applicant has claimed disability pension at the rate of 30% with effect from 26.05.2002 for life.</p>

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the applicant's claim for payment of disability has been discontinued with effect from 27.05.2002 for life vide letter No.G3/RA/06/03/1205/II dated 24.07.2003.

Learned counsel for the applicant prays for and is granted four weeks' time to move appropriate amendment application, challenging the impugned orders, by which the applicant is aggrieved.
