On the case being taken up for hearing applicant Shri Jyoti Prakash Pandey, who is present in person, submits that after Corrigendum P.P.O. being issued order under execution stands to be complied with to great extent. However, on account of no discharge book being issued on account of which applicant has no social as well as official recognition and he is not able to get Canteen Card and other facilities related to a soldier, a direction is required to be issued to respondents. He further submits that respondents have not deposited cost Rs.20,000/- as yet despite being directed to deposit by 14.12.2018 positively by order dated 15.11.2018 of this Tribunal.</p> <p>2. In reply, Mrs. Anju Singh, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that order under execution has been fully complied with.</p> <p>3. We have perused the order under execution and find that there is no mention it directing respondents to issue discharge book to the applicant. Even there is no mention in this regard in the Original Application including the reliefs claimed. In absence of any direction to respondents to issue discharge book to applicant in the order, no such direction can be given to respondents in the execution proceedings.</p> <p>4. As regards cost Rs.20,000/- being not paid, respondents have failed to show payment therefore they are directed to ensure its payment within four weeks from today failing which they shall additionally pay Rs.20,000/- along with cost.</p> <p>5. Counsel for the applicant submits that applicant had filed a Civil Misc. Writ Petition No. 18320 of 1995 in the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad which after constitution of this Regional Bench was transferred to this Regional Bench and renumbered as T.A. No. 978 of 2010. The applicant was not aware about the transfer of said Writ Petition as he was not able to contact his Counsel Shri M.P.N. Singh. He further submits that that said T.A. was listed before this Bench on 16.11.2010 for hearing but no one appeared on behalf of the applicant for want of notice and, consequently, registry was directed to put the case on 25.01.2011 and in the meantime notice was sent to the applicant at the address of his Counsel Shri M.P.N. Singh which was received back in the registry undelivered with remark 'left'. He further submits that T.A. was dismissed on 25.01.2011 in default presuming proceedings of Court Martial would have already been over and T.A. being infructuous on account of that. Thus, he submits that delay in filing application is not deliberate, but for the reasons stated above.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant further submits that applicant has filed Original Application No. 21 of 2018 against the respondents which is in progress before this Tribunal and the facts and circumstances of T.A. No. 978 of 2010 being directly connected with the said Original Application, the order needs to be recalled after condoning the delay of about nine years which is inadvertent and not intentional.</p> <p>The Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer and submitted that there is an inordinate delay of more than nine years in filing application and the same has not been properly and satisfactorily explained.</p>

Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that recall application has been filed with delay of more than nine years. We further find that the only reason assigned for delay in filing application is that applicant had no knowledge about the transfer of T.A. No. 978 of 2010 to this Tribunal. This contention of the applicant is not correct as it is apparent from the record that after the Civil Misc. Writ Petition being transferred from High Court of Judicature at Allahabad to this Bench not only the notice of transfer was sent to Counsel for the applicant at the address given in the Vakalatnama, but it was sent to the applicant also which was not received back undelivered. It is not the case of the applicant that notice addressed to him was not sent at his correct address.

The law regarding limitation is very clear that if statutes provides a time limit for filing any application/case, the same should be filed within same time and if it is not done so, the delay in filing application should not be fortuitously explained but it should be properly and satisfactorily explained while seeking condonation of delay. The proper and satisfactory explanation means day to day explanation.

If we consider the case in hand with above position of law, we find that applicant has utterly failed to offer day to day explanation of more than nine years delay in filing application. More so when he has also filed an Original Application in this Tribunal in respect of outcome of Court Martial proceedings. We also find that delay in filing application being not properly and satisfactorily explained, application deserves to be dismissed.

Accordingly, we **dismiss** the delay condonation application.

Recall application being time barred is also **dismissed**.

By way of this application petitioner wants to amend certain parts of the pleadings in Transfer Application regarding violation of his fundamental rights enshrined in Constitution, facts relating to Mental Health Act, 1987, facts relating to violation of UN Declaration of Human Rights Act, 1948, facts relating to violation of Directive Principles of the said policy and his illegal confinement after being annoyed due to statutory complaint made against some officers of the Air Force and with regard to consequential relief.</p> <p>2. Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner had filed Writ Petition in High Court for the redressal of his grievances on 26.09.1994. Further submission is that in the said Writ Petition pleadings were exchanged and after constitution of Armed Forces Tribunals, the Writ Petition was transferred to this Tribunal and registered as T.A. No. 1065 of 2010. In the said T.A. certain directions were issued to the Chief of Air Staff on 20.04.2017 directing him to conduct proper inquiry through an officer not below the rank of Air Marshal or set aside the impugned order and allow petitioner to retire in rank which he was holding and close the chapter once for all. His further submission is that despite this order, the Chief of Air Staff had whole inquiry. His further submission is that since the petitioner had made statutory complaint against some officers of the Air Force with copy to the office of the Chief of Air</p>

Staff, the officers of Air Force got annoyed with him with the result petitioner was made to undergo ill treatment violating his fundamental as well as legal rights. Thus, the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that to bring facts related to ill treatment meted out to the petitioner and to claim consequential relief regarding the same, proposed amendments are necessary to be made.

Further submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that officers against whom statutory complaints were made probably having been retired and their whereabouts being not known and further the Chief of Air Staff being vicariously labelled for the acts done by subordinates, their impleadment in T.A. is not necessary and therefore amendment in this regard have not been sought.

Respondents have vehemently opposed the prayer saying in view of order dated 18.08.2018 passed by the High Court in Writ Petition filed against orders dated 04.08.2018 and 15.05.2018 this Tribunal has to examine validity of the discharge order only and nothing beyond. It is further stated on their part that petitioner had moved two amendment applications earlier also and thus he being in habit of moving the same the present application deserves to be dismissed. It further stated that petitioner had made serious allegations against some officers of the Air Force and for that he has been directed by this Tribunal for their impleadment in the T.A. for making effective disposal and the same being not impleaded, application deserves to be dismissed on this core also. It is also stated that amendments are not allowed to be incorporated in the pleadings as in case being allowed the whole nature of the T.A. shall be changed.

Upon hearing submission of learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case we find that this Tribunal vide order dated 28.06.2017 had directed applicant to move fresh amendment application impleading necessary parties in T.A. in terms of pleadings. However, there is no prayer in amendment application regarding impleadment of the officers against whom allegations have been made rather it is said in this regard that there being nothing personal against officers and the Chief of Air

Staff being vicariously employed for the acts done by subordinates, their impleadment is not necessary. Petitioner has also stated that officers having retired and their whereabouts being not known their impleadment is not possible to be made at this time.

In regard to above, we find that there is a direction in the order dated 28.06.2017 regarding impleadment of alleged erring officials but the same is not necessary for the disposal of T.A. as allegations are not in the personal capacity but in official capacity.

As regards other amendments, they being factual in nature and related to violation of certain rights stated by petitioner and with regard to reliefs are liable to be allowed. We do not find force in respondents' contention that amendment would change nature of the T.A. as they are related with factual as well as legal position.

In view of above, we allow the amendment application and direct petitioner to carry out amendment in T.A. within a period of two weeks.

After amendment having been incorporated in T.A., copy of the same be served upon counsel for the respondents who shall file supplementary counter affidavit to the amended pleadings within three weeks from the date of receipt of copy.
