Counsel for the applicant and Shri Kaushik Chatterjee, Ld. Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant was enrolled in the Army on 11.07.1998 in Raj Rifle Centre & School, Delhi Cantt., and after serving nine years and six months was discharged from service on 31.01.2008 under Rule 13(3) item III (i) of the Army Rules, 1954. He further submitted that on 04.05.2007 the Officer Staff of 19 Raj Rifle forcefully took signature on resignation letter, when he was under the influence of liquor, in order to get him discharged from service about which he came to know during the month of August, 2007 only. He further submitted that discharge order to applicant had been issued two months prior to approval of the resignation letter which is a clear indicative of the fact that applicant's discharge was not at wish. He further submitted that applicant had tried to persuade the Officer of his Unit regarding his unwillingness to resign from the service and also that his signature on resignation letter was taken under influence of liquor but they did not listen to him. He further submitted that applicant has written a letter to Chief of the Army Staff also for reconsidering his matter, but despite the said letter written on 10.02.2008 the same is still undisposed off.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer and submitted that there is inordinate delay of more than nine years in filing Original Application and the same has not been properly and satisfactorily explained.</p>

After having heard the Ld. Counsel of both side and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that there is a delay of more than nine years in filing Original Application to which applicant has not assigned any sufficient reason. It appears that applicant was discharged from service at his wish as he himself had submitted resignation letter in this regard. Applicant's contention that his signature on resignation letter was taken from him while he was in the effect of liquor is not liable to be believed as he has not assigned reason why it was done with him. Thus, we find that no sufficient and satisfactory explanation being offered by the applicant for a long delay of more than nine years in filing Original Application, delay is not liable to be condoned.

Accordingly, we **dismiss** the delay condonation application.

Original Application being barred by time is also **dismissed**.
