Sub section 2 of Section 31 of the Act (supra) provides as under:-</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>“(2) An application to the Tribunal for leave to appeal to the Supreme Court shall be made within a period of thirty days beginning with the date of the decision of the Tribunal and an application to the Supreme Court for leave shall be made within a period of thirty days beginning with the date on which the application for leave is refused by the Tribunal”.</i></p> <p>In view of above leave to appeal may be granted only in case some question of law of public importance is involved, meaning thereby where a question has not been adjudicated or settled by Court of law or Rules and Regulations.</p> <p>Shri V.P.S. Vats, Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents assisted by Col Ajeen Kumar, Col MS (Legal) raised certain issues which are discussed as under:-</p>

1. Submission of Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents is that denial to make Annual Confidential Report entry after retirement is contrary to Army jurisprudence. Arguments advanced by Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents seems to be misconceived for the reason that a number of cases of Hon'ble Supreme Court have been referred whereby difference between a person superannuated and working has been dealt with. It is well settled law that once relationship of master and servant breaks then all rights to discharge duties come to an end. Nothing has been brought on record to indicate that under the law such power has been conferred by Army Act or Rules framed thereunder. Needless to say that such privilege may be given by some statutory provision or rules duly affirmed by the Parliament keeping in view Article 33 of the Constitution of India if framed or legislated. We feel that conferring power to the retired Army officers to make entry in the service record of serving officers shall be anti thesis to the command and control of the Army and further it may open a gallery for corrupt practice. In the present case no such rule or statutory provision has been pointed out under which such power has been conferred by the Parliament.

2. The second submission of the Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents is that observation made with regard to pen picture is not substantiated. The importance of pen picture has been dealt with under the guidelines as discussed in para 32 of the impugned order. We have already held, relying on the guidelines, that the purpose of pen picture is to provide valuable input for selection of officers for important and sensitive appointments. Pen picture has been discussed in para 36 of the guidelines and para 32 of the impugned order, we do not think that some new line has been drawn with regard to pen picture and the finding is based on own guidelines and Army Orders framed by the applicant-respondents.

3. So far as award of PVSM, AVSM and VSM is concerned, they are not given as a token merely because the incumbent is serving in the Indian Army. These awards are granted on account of exemplary work and courage shown by

the officers while discharging their duty. Observation made with regard to awards is well founded. In the present case the officer has held command of three operational field formations for which he was given Presidential awards on all the three occasions. In such situation the awards given to the petitioner cannot be ignored while making Annual Confidential Report entries in the service record. We have already held that purpose to make Annual Confidential Report entry is not just numerical assessment but to look into cumulative performance the qualities of the officer concerned.

We do not feel that any substantial question of law of public importance is involved which may make out a case for grant of leave to appeal. Findings recorded in the impugned order are based on catena of judgments of Hon'ble Supreme Court and statutory provisions contained in the Army Act, Rules framed thereunder and the Army Orders. There appears to be no gap or vacuum for which leave to appeal may be granted to the applicant-respondents to approach Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Accordingly the application is **rejected** having no merit.
