Appointment of members of GCM from the waiting list by the Presiding Officer is not permissible after commencement of trial.</li><li>6. An officer not within the jurisdiction of the convening authority cannot be member of the GCM convened by such authority.</li><li>7. The trial was time barred.</li><li>8. request the applicant was denied reasonable opportunity to defend his cause.

9. Copy of the police report, general diary and complaint made by the complainant was required to be summoned but was denied.
10. After examination of prosecution witnesses the accused was examined under Army Rule 58 and trial was re-opened in pursuance to application moved by the prosecution (Exhibit-69) in spite of the protest by the applicant (Exhibit-70).
11. Judge Advocate tempered the record which is offence under Section 57 (c) of the Army Act, and requires to be punished.
12. Trial was conducted in haste manner and the witnesses were terrorized and abused.
13. Re-trial was held in violation of law propounded by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Satyajit Banerjee & Ors vs. State of WB & Ors**, 2005 (1) SCC 115 and **Dhanpal vs State by Public Prosecutor** (2009) Cri. L.J. 4647.

In strict sense, the order of the Tribunal stands complied with by issuing the PPO. The Applicant shall also have the liberty to represent his case</p>

to the competent authority pointing out the shortcomings if any.

Thus, the Execution Application is rendered infructuous and is accordingly dismissed as having become infructuous.
