Counsel for the respondents assisted by Maj Soma John, OIC Legal Cell and perused the records.</p> <p>Present petition has been filed for fixation of pension @ Rs 16,145/- from the date of retirement of the applicant, i.e. 01.10.2007.</p> <p>During course of hearing it has fairly been admitted by Ld. Counsel for the respondents assisted by OIC Legal Cell that applicant's pension has been revised and he is being paid pension to the tune of Rs 16,145/- p.m. with effect from 24.09.2014. Now the question relates only to arrears of pension in terms of revised pension for the period 01.10.2007 to 23.09.2012.</p> <p>There is no justification on the part of the respondents to deny payment of pension of equal amount with effect from the date of retirement.</p>

Accordingly we **dispose** of the O.A. finally directing the respondents to pay arrears of pension keeping in view the difference of pension for the period 01.10.2007 to 23.09.2012 as revised. The difference of pension which has been paid and now has been revised on 24.09.2012 shall be paid to the applicant expeditiously within four months from today. Ld. Counsel for the respondents as well as OIC Legal Cell shall communicate the order forthwith to the authorities concerned.

It is clarified that in case the respondents fail to give effect to this order within the stipulated time, the applicant shall be entitled to receive interest @ 10% per annum from the respondents on the amount accrued from due date till the date of actual payment.

No order as to costs.

Copy of the order be supplied to Ld. Counsel for the parties free of cost by 30.06.2017.

In case the applicant is aggrieved by the order dated 28.03.2016 on merit with regard to relief granted, option is open to the applicant to move special appeal under Section 31 of</p>

the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. In the absence of any error apparent on the face of record, the review petition lacks merit and is accordingly rejected.
