No. 135 of 2017.</p> <p>Solitary arguments advanced by Ld. Counsel for the applicant is that since the respondent-applicant (Shambhu Dayal Shrivastava) completed 15 years of service hence he could have been granted disability only to the extent of 20% and could not have been rounded off as has been done while passing the impugned order.</p> <p>Arguments advanced by Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents seem to be mis-conceived. The impugned order has been passed literally following the law settled by Hon'ble Supreme Court. Arguments advanced by Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents to not raise any substantial question of law which is condition precedent for grant of leave to appeal under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007.</p> <p>Application lacks merit.
