It has been further submitted that on the basis of aforesaid incorrect statement, the execution application was wrongly rejected, hence prayer has been made for recall of the said order dated 05.10.2016.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">A perusal of order dated 10.07.2015 shows that the</p>

representation of the applicant has been decided by OIC Records with the finding that no merit has been found in the same. However, the order of the Tribunal shows that direction was issued to the respondent/competent authority to decide the representation. Here, the competent authority is the Chief of the Army Staff, to whom the representation was preferred. As such, the same was to be decided by the Chief of the Army Staff.

We, thus, find that the order dated 05.10.2016 is suffering from the error apparent on the face of record, which was passed on the basis of an incorrect statement made inadvertently by OIC Legal Cell. Accordingly, the application is allowed and the order dated 05.10.2016 is recalled.

We permit the respondents to forward the representation of the applicant with comments of OIC Records to the Chief of Army Staff, who shall decide the same in terms of the order dated 22.05.2015 passed in OA No. 311 of 2013. Let compliance report be submitted to the Tribunal by the next date.

Place of filing application.- (1) An application shall ordinarily be filed by the applicant with the Registrar of the Bench within whose jurisdiction-</p> <p>(i) The applicant is posted for the time being, or was last posted or attached; or</p> <p>(ii) Where the cause of action, wholly or in part, has arisen: Provided that with the leave of the Chairperson the application may be filed with the Registrar of the Principal Bench and subject to the orders under section 14 or section 15 of the Act, such application shall be heard and disposed of by the Bench which has jurisdiction over the</p>

matter.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), a person who has ceased to be in service by reason of his retirement, dismissal, discharge, cashiering release, removal, resignation or termination of service may, at his option, file an application with the Registrar of the Bench within whose jurisdiction such person is ordinarily residing at the time of filing of the application.”

A plain reading of the aforesaid Rule shows that the Applicant may file Application with the Registrar of the Bench within whose jurisdiction (i) the applicant is posted for the time being, or was last posted, or attached; or (ii) where the cause of action, wholly or in part, has arisen. In the present case, the petitioner has not served within the jurisdiction of Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench Lucknow; that he belongs to Bihar and further that the impugned order was passed within the jurisdiction of Armed Forces Tribunal Regional Bench at Jaipur Rajasthan. Hence, it is either for the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench Jaipur or the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench at Kolkatta to exercise jurisdiction over the case in hand. It would appear that even part of jurisdiction does not arise within the jurisdiction of Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench Lucknow.

In view of the above, let the record of the case be transmitted to the Principal Bench at New Delhi to pass appropriate orders for relegating the matter to the appropriate forum in terms of Rule 6 of the Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2008.

It is clarified that the above order has been passed in the presence of Shri Rohit Kumar, counsel for the Petitioner and Dr Chet Narain Singh, learned counsel for the respondents after hearing them at length.
