Heard Maj. S.M. Mustafa (Retd.) and Shri V.P. Pandey, Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Shri Bipin Kumar Singh, Ld. Counsel for the respondents. The instant Original Application has been filed under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 for issuing direction to the respondents to conduct Re-Assessment Medical Board (RAMB) to ascertain the persistence of disability Hypertension and to grant disability element of disability pension in terms of disability found in RAMB. Briefly stated, facts of the case are that the applicant was enrolled in the Grenadiers Regiment of Indian Army on 27.04.1993 and discharged from the service on 30.09.2023 on fulfilling the conditions of his enrolment under Rule 13(3) Item I (i) (a) of the Army Rules, 1954 after rendering 30 years, 05 months and 07 days of service. The Release Medical Examination held at Military Hospital, Aurangabad on 12.04.2023 assessed the applicant fit to be released from service in medical classification SHAPE-1. The applicant is in receipt of service pension. As per averments made by the applicant in the Original Application, the applicant detected to have Primary Hypertension during his posting at Srinagar (J & K) in July, 2013 and he was treated at 92 Base Hospital. The Medical Board held on 25.07.2013 placed the applicant in low medical category S1H1A1Ps (T-24) for 24 weeks with observation that the onset of hypertensions was due to stress and strain of military service in CI Operation. The next categorisation Board was due on 09.01.2014 at nearest Military Hospital. The Re-Categorization Medical Board of the applicant was held on 29.01.2014 at 92 Base Hospital, Srinagar and the applicant was placed

in S1H1A1P2 (P) for two years and assessed the degree of disability @30%. The next categorization board was due on 09.01.2016. the applicant was recommended for NSG by his Commanding Officer in 2015 and referred the case for medical opinion. The applicant pointed out to his CO that he is suffering with hypertension and his next categorization is scheduled on 09.01.2016. The applicant was forced to appear before the categorization board in 2015 without keeping in mind the previous opinion of medical board that next categorization board was due in 2016. The applicant's medical board was conducted at 414 Field Hospital on 07.07.2015 without following the instructions of the previous board and the applicant's category was upgraded to SHAPE-1 with effect from 07.07.2015 with Primary Hypertension and advised the applicant to continue with medicine. The applicant was sent to National Security Guards for three years from September, 2016 to September, 2019. The applicant was examined in MI Room of the Grenadiers RC on 19.09.2023 (11 days before the discharge) wherein the applicant was prescribed certain medicine so as to cure the persistent problem. The applicant has been living his life with the persistence of disability Hypertension and is still undergoing consultation and treatment with ECHS and Command Hospital. The applicant has filed copies of relevant medical board proceedings and medical documents. The applicant preferred application dated 14.12.2023 for conduct of Re-Assessment Medical Board which too was rejected vide letter dated 18.01.2024. It is in this perspective that the applicant has preferred the present Original Application.

5. Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that at the time of enrolment, the applicant was found mentally and physically fit for service in the Army and there is no note in the service documents that he was suffering from any disease at the time of enrolment in the Army. The respondents did not conduct Release Medical Board of the applicant while in service even after knowing that the applicant is continuously taking treatment for the aforesaid disability. Thus, the present disability has a strong causal connection that the disability was contacted during the service tenure only. The applicant has manifested with the aforesaid disability i.e. Primary Hypertension during his posting at Srinagar (J & K) in July, 2013 due to stress and strain of military service in CI Operation. Thus, it ought to be considered as attributable to or aggravation by Army Service. He relied upon Para 8(a) of the Entitlement Rules for the Casualty Pensionary Awards to the Armed Forces Personnel, 2008.

6. Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that the applicant has proceeded on discharge in the medical category SHAPE-1 after undergoing Release Medical Examination at his last unit and notably, the applicant did not report any medical complaints during the Board proceedings, which indicates that the applicant was suffering from 'NIL' disease. Before discharge from the service, Release Medical Examination held at Military Hospital, Aurangabad

on 12.04.2023 found that the applicant was in medical category SHAPE1 with no disability detected/claimed. Further, the applicant had not claimed any disability and he has given no such information about his health vide Para 3, 5 & 6 of Part-I (Personal Statement) respectively of AFMSF-18 dated 12.04.2023. As such there is no need for issuing direction to hold Re-Assessment Medical Board (RAMB) to assess the disability of the applicant and the applicant is not entitled for the grant of disability element of disability pension.

7. Para 8(a) of the Entitlement Rules for the Casualty Pensionary Awards to the Armed Forces Personnel, 2008 reads as under :-

“8. Post discharge claims:

(a) Cases in which a disease was not present at the time of the member’s retirement/discharge from service but arose within 7 years thereafter, may be recognized as attributable to service if it can be established by the competent medical authority that the disability is delayed manifestation of a pathological process set in motion by service conditions obtaining prior to discharge.”

8. Upon hearing submission of Ld. Counsel of both the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case especially Para 8(a) of the Entitlement Rules for the Casualty Pensionary Awards to the Armed Forces Personnel, 2008, the applicant suffering from the aforesaid disability from July, 2013 and that the applicant was discharged from service on 30.09.2023, we **dispose of** the Original Application finally with a direction to the respondents to conduct Re-Assessment Medical Board (RAMB) of the applicant to assess his disability for deciding entitlement of disability element of disability pension within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

9. Let a copy of this order be provided to the learned Counsel for the parties.
