The instant Original Application has been filed under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 for issuing direction to the respondents to set aside the order dated 14.02.2024 and also to conduct Re-Survey Medical Board (RSMB) for assessment of present medical condition/ disability percentage of the applicant and to grant disability element of disability persion in terms of disability found in RSMB. Briefly stated, facts of the case are that the applicant was enrolled in the Army Medical Corps of Indian Army on 08.06.1994 and discharged from the service on 30.06.2020 on fulfilling the conditions of his enrolment under Rule 13(3) Item III (i) of the Army Rules, 1954 after rendering 26 years and 23 days of service. The Release Medical Examination held at Military Hospital, Jalandhar Cantt. on 30.12.2019 assessed the applicant is in receipt of service pension. As per averments made by the applicant in the Original Application, after discharge of four months only, the applicant felt abnormality in breathing and other activities of body. He was admitted to the Command Hospital wherein he was diagnosed as (a) AA-ICD to be entered later and (b) CAD-ACS IWMI/CARDIOGENIC SHOCK T2 DMHYPOTHYROIDISMHTN. The applicant's medical condition became worsen and he was again admitted in 				
	Command Hospital wherein he underwent Coronary Angiography and Coronary Angioplasty. He was then diagnosed with (a) 125.4-Coronary Artery				

Aneurysm (b) CAD-ACS IWMI, PCI TO RCA, (c) PCI to LAD and (d) Type-II DM. The applicant preferred a representation dated 07.06.2023 followed by first reminder dated 28.07.2023 and second reminder dated 15.09.2023 for holding of RSMB. He again preferred a representation dated 06.10.2023 for holding of RSMB and grant of disability element of disability pension which was rejected vide letter dated 14.02.2024 by the respondents.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that at the time of enrolment, the 5. applicant was found mentally and physically fit for service in the Army and there is no note in the service documents that he was suffering from any disease at the time of enrolment in the Army. The diseases have occurred within two years of discharge. During the service period he served in more difficult uncongenial climatic condition and terrain, hence, applicant's disabilities be deemed to be attributable to or aggravated by military service. Thus, the present disabilities have strong causal connection with the difficult services rendered by the applicant. The applicant has manifested with the aforesaid disabilities are due to stress and strain of military service. Thus, it ought to be considered as attributable to or aggravation by Army Service. He relied upon the Regulation 86 of Pension Regulation for the Army 2008, Part-I which holds that in the event of manifestation of disability after retirement/ discharge, disability pension is admissible only if the disease is accepted as attributable to military service.

6. Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that the applicant has proceeded on discharge in the medical category SHAPE-1 after undergoing Release Medical Examination at his last unit and notably, the applicant did not report any medical complaints during the Board proceedings. Before discharge from the service, Release Medical Examination held at Military Hospital, Jalandhar Cantt. on 30.12.2019 found that the applicant was in medical category SHAPE1 with no disability detected/claimed. He approached the respondents vide his letters dated 07.06.2023 and 06.10.2023 for conducting the RSMB which have been processed at the respondents' end. Office of the DGAFMS/MA (Pension) has intimated vide letter dated 05.02.2024 that the applicant does not fulfil the criteria for PDC as per Rule 9 of Entitlement Rues 2023. Respondents' counsel further submitted that the applicant was discharged from service in medical category SHAPE-I whereas the applicants in various court orders herein relied upon by the applicant were invalided/discharged in low medical category.

7. Para 8(a) of the Entitlement Rules for the Casualty Pensionary Awards to the Armed Forces Personnel, 2008 reads as under :-

"8. Post discharge claims:

 (a) Cases in which a disease was not present at the time of the member's retirement/discharge from service but arose within 7 years thereafter, may be recognized as attributable to service if it can be established by the competent medical authority that the disability is delayed manifestation of a pathological process set in motion by service conditions obtaining prior to discharge."

8. Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case especially Para 8(a) of the Entitlement Rules for the Casualty Pensionary Awards to the Armed Forces Personnel, 2008, the applicant suffering from the aforesaid disabilities from 09.06.2022 i.e. within two years of discharge and that the applicant was discharged from service on 30.06.2020, we **dispose of** the Original Application finally with a direction to the respondents to conduct Re-Survey Medical Board (RSMB) of the applicant to assess his disability for deciding entitlement of disability element of disability pension within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
