The order dated 23.02.2023 is an ex-parte order and we are of the considered view that reasons shown in the affidavit is sufficient and there is no reason to disbelieve the personal affidavit of the counsel of the applicant. It is just and proper to recall the impugned order and decide the case on merit.

8. In view of the above application is allowed and order dated 23.02.2023 is recalled. M.A. No. 521 of 2023 is disposed off.
