His further submission is that the delay caused due to departmental correspondents. Thus, his submission is that delay is not deliberate, but for the reasons mentioned above and time taken by the department in processing the case for filing of the present application, delay of 03 months and 03 days is condonable in filing application for leave to appeal.</p> <p>We have gone through the affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application and we find that the ground and reasons shown in the accompanying affidavit for condonation of delay seem sufficient and therefore, delay in filing application is condoned.
