This is an application for condonation of delay in filing application for leave to appeal.</p> <p>3. There is delay of 01 month and 09 days in filing leave to appeal.</p> <p>4. Submission of learned counsel for the applicants-Union of India & Others is that delay in filing leave to appeal is not deliberate, but for the reasons that some time has taken place in getting instructions from the department in processing the case for filing of the present application, therefore, delay of 01 month and 09 days is condonable in filing application for leave to appeal.</p> <p>5. We have gone through the affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application and find that the grounds and reasons shown in the accompanying affidavit for condonation of delay seem sufficient and therefore, delay in filing application is condoned.
