She had also filed Original Application No. 524 of 2021 before this Tribunal for family pension on ground of presuming her husband 'missing presumed dead'.</p> <p>4. The Original application No. 524 of 2021 was dismissed vide judgment and order dated 06.05.2022 passed by this Tribunal on the ground that her husband has already been dismissed from service.</p> <p>5. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents opposed the prayer stating that applicant is trying to take shelter behind normal occurrences of life for his own inaction and has not approached the Tribunal within stipulated time, hence, prayer of the applicant is not entertainable and is liable to be dismissed.</p> <p>6. Heard learned counsel for the parties on admission and perused the record.</p> <p>7. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the parties and cause of delay shown in affidavit of delay condonation application, we are of the view that though there is long delay in filing the O.A. but it was not intentional but due to reason mentioned in affidavit. Applicant being an illiterate</p>

lady was approaching different forum for grant of family pension. Hence, grounds stated in affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application being sufficient, delay is liable to be condoned. Accordingly, delay caused in filing of application is condoned. Delay condonation application stands disposed off.
