There is delay of 50 years, 05 months and 06 days in filing this Original Application.</p> <p>3. This Misc. Application has been filed for condoning the delay in filing Original Application.</p> <p>4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that applicant was discharged from service on completion of 09 years, 04 months and 26 days of service. Thereafter, he has been making representations and also approached the authorities but nothing was done. The delay is bonafide and not intentional. It is pensionary matter in which bar of limitation is not applicable. Reliance has been placed on the judgments passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Deoki Nandan Prasad vs. State of Bihar, AIR 1971 SC Page 1409 and Union of India & Others vs. Tarsem Singh, reported in 2009 (1) AISLJ 371.</p> <p>5. Learned counsel for the respondents has filed his objection on delay condonation application and vehemently opposed the prayer for condoning the delay. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that there is delay of more than 50 years in filing Original Application. The explanation of delay offered by the applicant is not sufficient and it should be dismissed.</p> <p>6. It is further submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that due to lapse on the part of the applicant in approaching in time, the record itself has been destroyed. Therefore, there is no ground for condonation of delay in filing present Original Application.</p>

7. Undisputedly delay. It is pensionary matter in which cause of action does not accrue on a fixed date. The matter being a case of continuing wrong, cause of action accrue from month to month. Considering this aspect and observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Deoki Nandan Prasad** (supra) and **Tarsem Singh** (supra), since the applicant is claiming invaliding pension which is valuable right of the Govt. servant, therefore, in the interest of justice, the delay in filing Original Application is condoned. In case the applicant is held entitled to any relief, the same will be restricted to three years prior to filing of Original Application. M.A. stand disposed off accordingly.
