Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>Objection against compliance report filed by the applicant is taken on record.</p> <p>Brief facts of the case are that applicant was recruited in Indian Army as Sweeper. He successfully completed his basic military training. While on leave, cattle stepped over the right foot of the applicant. He was treated in Base Hospital Lucknow. He was placed in low medical category and finally invalided out of service. He filed application before this Tribunal for conducting re-survey medical board which was allowed and respondents were directed to conduct of fresh Re-survey medical board. His re-survey medical board was conducted and applicant was found unfit for military service.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant has filed Execution Application stating that re-survey medical board of the applicant was conducted at Base Hospital, Lucknow in a prejudiced way as applicant was not re-examined by a medical board and order of the Tribunal has not been complied with fully. Subordinate of the Doctor was told to prepare medical documents similar to that of the earlier medical board proceedings on the basis of which the applicant was boarded out of Army Service. The applicant was forced to sign the medical</p>

papers by Lt Col Ravindra Chauhan and Maj Aditya Dwivedi but he refused to sign the same. The order of the Tribunal dated 10.08.2021 passed in O.A. No 515 of 2019 was not complied with in letter and spirit. Learned counsel for the applicant pleaded that directions may be issued to respondents to conduct an impartial re-survey medical board of the applicant as ordered by this Tribunal.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents submitted that applicant was granted 30 days recruit leave from 25.03.2019 to 23.04.2019 and he sustained injury while leave. After termination of of leave, applicant reported pain in his leg. He was referred to Base Hospital, Lucknow and he was treated. A Court of Inquiry was held and applicant was invalided out of service in Low Medical Category A5. Injury of the applicant was found as neither attributable to nor aggravated by military service. Applicant filed application before this Tribunal for conducted of fresh re-survey medical board. In compliance of order passed by this Tribunal, re-survey medical board of the applicant was conducted and applicant was found unfit for army service by medical board. He submitted that order of the Tribunal has been complied with and applicant has no case. Execution Application has no substance and is liable to be dismissed.

We have heard learned counsel of both the parties and perused the documents available on record.

In the instant case, applicant was invalided out from service on 10.07.2019. He is a young trained soldier and Govt has expended lot of money in his training. He was enrolled in the army in the trade of Sweeper and this category of soldiers are required sympathetic consideration. The applicant belongs from a poor family. His re-survey medical board was held at Base Hospital, Lucknow. Applicant has alleged that Doctors at Base Hospital, Lucknow directed their subordinate to prepare medical documents similar to that of the earlier medical board proceedings on the basis of which the applicant was boarded out of Army Service. No actual Medical Board of the applicant was conducted considering the status of the injury. Applicant was

forced to sign blank papers. Recommendations of Medical Board proceedings have been prepared mechanically and without assessment of the present condition of the applicant's injury. In Re-survey Medical Board, Part- V, dated 28.09.2022, regarding locomotor system, it is mentioned as NAD (No Any Defect) which also shows that the applicant has no physical disability. Applicant submits that he has no problem in his leg and he is fit. At this stage, neither the applicant can be granted disability pension nor he can be taken into service.

Accordingly, keeping in view the future of young soldier, respondents are further directed to conduct a fresh impartial re-survey medical board of the applicant in which Lt Col Ravindra Chauhan and Major Aditya Dwivedi shall not be member. Commandant Base Hospital, Lucknow shall ensure that medical board of the applicant is conducted in an impartial manner within 30 days from today to ascertain whether the applicant is fit for service in the Army. Respondents shall intimate the date of fresh medical board and applicant shall appear before medical board at Base Hospital, Lucknow on the date fixed for assessing his medical condition. If the applicant is found fit, he shall be permitted to join his duty.

Copy of this order be provided to learned counsel for the respondents for processing the case.

With aforesaid directions, Execution Application is **disposed of**.
