Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. India Ltd and another reported in 2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:

"Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments" and since "the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly binds everybody including the Government."

The Hon'ble Supreme Court further observed as under:

"Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitation .......They cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings".
