Counsel for the applicant, and Maj Piyush Thakran, OIC Legal Cell.</p> <p>We have heard learned counsel for the parties on admission.</p> <p>Present Tribunal vide order dated 12.12.2011 rendered in T.A.No 1221 of 2010 directed the respondents to pay disability pension assessed at 20% for a period of two years with effect from the date the disability occurred i.e 5th Dec 1992 to 5th Dec 1994 attended with direction to hold Review Medical Board to re-assess the disability of the Applicant. It is submitted that the Review Medical Board was conducted on 20.04.2012 by which the disability of the Applicant was again assessed at 20% for life. The grievance in the instant case is that the Applicant has been paid disability pension for the period from 5th Dec 1992 to 5th Dec 1994 and thereafter with effect from 20.04.2012 while for the period from 6th Dec 1994 till 19.04.2012 he has not been paid any disability pension. The intendment of the order of the Tribunal prima facie seems to be to keep on making payment of the disability pension subject to the assessment to be made by the Review Medical Board at the interval of two years. By this reckoning, the order of the Tribunal has not been observed in compliance in its letter and spirit.</p>

The office in its report has indicated delay of 23 years, 4 months and 18 days.

We have given our anxious consideration to this aspect. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that there is no delay at all and that the Application for condonation of delay has been filed on the insistence of the office.

In our considered view, there appears to be no delay regard being had to the order of the Tribunal which is dated 12.12.2011. It would appear that disability pension has been paid for two years but it was withheld for the interregnum period. M.A. aforesaid shall stand disposed of in terms of the above.

In view of the above, we find it a fit case for admission.

Learned counsel for the respondents may file counter affidavit within six weeks.

(Butt No G 1987) during course of hearing which has been produced before us and demonstrated by Col JG Manhas who stated that a self inflicted injury may be caused by 9 m.m. Carbine Machine Gun (C.M.G.) which was used by the applicant. The medical report produced before the Tribunal shows that no burn injury was found over the body of the applicant.</p> <p>The statement with regard to injury report given by Capt Shatish Kumar as prosecution witness No 6 shows that he made a categorical statement that there was no burn mark or any other injury on the body of the applicant. He further stated that the applicant suffered gunshot injury with entry of about 1 cm above the middle part of the left clavicle and the exit wound on the back side of the body about 5 cm from the spine of left shoulder.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents wants time to prepare the case. He also wants to file an affidavit. On perusal of certified copy of leave certificate it seems that leave was sanctioned for 60 days. However the date in the first column is typed as April 1990 to June 1990 but date is written in hand i.e. 14 April 1990 to 12 Jun 1990. We could not find any cutting in the leave certificate as observed during Court Martial proceedings while recording the statement of prosecution witness No 3. Column 1 seems to have been filled up and other columns are left blank.

During course of reading of statement of PW. 3 we also perused the leave certificate on record sent by 7-Air Force Hospital, Kanpur to the Unit at Srinagar on demand. It shows that the leave was sanctioned for the period commencing from 08.04.1990 to 06.06.1990 and signed by Adjutant, Maj Salim Asif of 6-Rajput Regiment. The dates have been typed and not handwritten. The remarks made by the Court Martial contains that the dates have been filled in by the same ink.

Keeping in view the disparity in the record, let the entire record produced before the Tribunal be kept in sealed cover and placed before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.

We are constrained to mention that in spite of repeated orders passed by the Tribunal, unfortunately the original records have not been produced and whatever has been produced seems to be Certified True Copy.

The record shall be kept with the Registrar of the Tribunal in sealed cover and as directed above be produced before the Tribunal on the next date of listing.

Col GJ Manhas, OIC Legal Cell submits that he shall inform the Tribunal on next date the exact distance from Niari to Srinagar. OIC Legal Cell shall also apprise the Tribunal with regard to habitats, availability of infrastructure and hospitals at Niari.
