In case any such representation is preferred within one month from today, the same shall be considered in all its pros and cons and disposed of by a speaking and reasoned order taking into consideration the mandate of policy dated 16.05.2008, a copy of which has been filed as Annexure R-1 to the counter affidavit within six weeks from the date the representation is preferred. The order so passed, shall be communicated to the Applicant immediately thereafter.

In view of the above, the O.A is finally disposed of in terms of the above directions.

	O.A. The period of limitation is to be counted from the date when		
	the impugned orders were passed and cause of action arose.		
	We have considered the arguments advanced by Ld.		
	Counsel for the parties and perused the record.		
	Arguments advanced by Ld. Counsel for the respondents		
	seems to be correct that limitation should be reckoned from the		

date cause of action arose which seems to be on 01.10.2014. Ofcourse, the applicant has submitted certain representations raising grievance with the allegation that he has not been permitted to resume duty, but whether the representations submitted by the applicant constitute cause of action? Needless to say that sometimes representations are fabricated; and sometimes without sending any representation case is cooked up for the purpose of condonation of delay. There are cases where people seem to allegedly send representations and then come before the Tribunal with submission that no delay has been caused. Accordingly, limitation should be considered keeping in view the relief claimed by the applicant which in the present cse is for quashing of order dated 01.10.2014 and other orders of earlier date. O.A. should have been filed within period of six months in terms of Section 22 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. The representations submitted by the applicant may be a ground for condonation of delay subject to genuineness of representations and objection filed by the respondents to the application for condonation of delay. In the present case neither any application for condonation of delay has been filed nor attention of the Tribunal has been invited to any pleading on record to condone delay.

It is well settled law that decision is to be taken and order be passed in terms of pleading on record and relief claimed. Since the O.A. has been preferred after the statutory period of limitation and that too without any pleading and prayer for condonation of delay, it seems to be not maintainable.

In view of above, the O.A. being barred by limitation deserves to be dismissed being not maintainable.

Accordingly **dismissed** in limine.

This is an application for grant of leave to appeal to approach Hon'ble Supreme Court against final order dated 30.05.2016 passed in T.A. No. 1122 of 2010 and order dated 20.07.2016 passed in Review Application No 82 of 2016: **VD Tiwari vs. Union of India & others.**

Ld Counsel for the applicant vehemently argued that period of limitation should be counted from the date of disposal of application for review i.e. review application No. 82 of 2016 decided on 20.07.2016 though the original T.A. was decided on 30.05.2016

Rebutting arguments submitted by Ld. Counsel for the applicant, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that period of limitation is to be reckoned from the date of original judgment/order and not from the date when review application was rejected.

Under the Limitation Act, 1963 period of limitation is to be reckoned from the date of original order. Ofcourse delay may be condoned in case some application for condonation of delay is moved but that too by the competent court. The Tribunal lacks jurisdiction to condone the delay under the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. It is well settled proposition of law that the Tribunal is not empowered to condone delay in moving application for leave to appeal.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant has placed reliance on Full Bench decision of Orissa High Court, Cuttack in W.P. (C) No 5738 of 2008 **Akshay Kumar Parida (dead) vs. Union of India & Others.** We are afraid we cannot subscribe to the dictum of Full Bench decision of Orissa High Court, Cuttack (supra) in view of the mandatory provision of Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 where in it is provided that an application to the Tribunal for leave to appeal to the Supreme Court shall be made within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of the decision of the Tribunal.

Accordingly application for condonation of delay in moving application for grant of leave to appeal is not maintainable and is **rejected.**

The said writ petition was transferred to the Tribunal in terms of the provisions of section 34 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 and it was this Tribunal which dismissed the T.A with liberty to file fresh O.A. vide order dated 18.07.2016.

In view of the above, we do not feel that there is any delay in preferring the present O.A. Accordingly the preliminary objection raised orally before this Tribunal is rejected as unsustainable.

Coming to the question of admission, it is submitted by learned counsel for the Applicant that the Applicant had overstayed the leave for 31 days and it was on account of serious illness of his son and accordingly, the order of dismissal from service by way of holding summary court martial is not sustainable, keeping in view the mandate contained in section 39 (b) of the Army Act.

In view of the above, the petition is admitted.

Let counter affidavit be filed within six weeks. Rejoinder affidavit if any, may be filed within two weeks next thereafter.

avowed object of screening the higher officers. Relevant

portion of the allegations as contained in the complaint dated 4th May 2009 are reproduced below.

"I reached at 7.30 AM on 28.12.2008 at 4 ASC centre Barrackpore. I was examined by Sgn Ldr. Anshu Mishra, Dr also written fit but one from staff came and said madam you have unfit against me. This was not only with me but was done with 15 candidates. I requested Dr madam that I am likely to be overage & my joining has also come late. The madam said bear as you have done. You to go AF Station Bagdogra get yourself declared fit by any means.

X X X X X X X

On 17 April I went for 158 BH but medical exam was not done reason not known. Thereafter I was called on 20 April 2009 there were 9 other candidates with me. I was asked to sit in front, Nursing Asstt N.K.G Kumar alongwith medical document went to Lt Col S.Mukherjee Pointing with form at me said his payment is not received. This was also heard by my father standing near door and wil tell you if asked. I said my medical was also done by E Nt Spl Col J.P.Devedi at Namkum he said as normal. Thereafter I got it examined at Gajendra Institute of Sc at Ranchi there Govt Dr has said TM intact on bath said and bill hearing with normal limits on this Lt Col S Mukharjee threw all papers and said like this money comes every day before us on this my father said to Dr 9 years don't have faith on me than please talk to ENT SPI Col J.P.Dwivedi at MH Namkum and confirm. On this reticently picked up phone and booked through Army exchange call to MHY Namkum & talk to Col J.P.Dwivedi gave advice to Lt Col S.Mukharjee said as I have written unfit & if written fit after cutting I will be in fix. Then advised my father to annex other medical opinion & go for appeal medical board than I will make him fit sir by not hearing request of unemployed youth and the parents you have revised the enter prices. That limit end, when ignoring other paper in the garb of medical examination this dictatorship of Drs will continue. System to take steps against bribery."

It would thus transpire that allegations against various officers have not been touched upon by the Court of Inquiry.

In view of the above, it would be appropriate for the Chief of the Air Staff to look into the matter and hold enquiry against those who are actually involved in racket of recruitment regard being had to the allegations made in the complaint. In case the Applicant is not the sole person as prima facie appears from the allegations in the complaint, and he was used by some higher officer, then prima facie, he cannot be made scapegoat for major penalty like dismissal from service.

It has been pointed out that even in the additional term of reference, names of other higher air force officers who have been specifically mentioned in the complaint do not appear.

List this case on 10.01.2017 for hearing.

Let a copy of the present order be sent to the Chief of the Air Staff to look into the matter and institute an enquiry and submit report so that keeping in view the finding record in such inquiry report, the controversy involved in the present case touching on the service career of the Applicant may be settled.

It may be clarified that none of the observations made in this order shall be construed as an observation on merit and they have been made with the avowed object of unearthing the truth and to undo if any injustice has been done to the Applicant.
