Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 provides that the application for leave to appeal <u>shall</u> be made for approaching Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of decision of the Tribunal. Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for condoning the delay are general in nature and do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another reported in 2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:</p> <p><i>“Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments” and since “the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly binds everybody including the Government.”</i></p>

The Hon'ble Supreme Court further observed as under :

“Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitationThey cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings”.

In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.

M.A. No. 1791 of 2016

This is an application under section 31 (1) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the applicant beyond the period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.

Even otherwise also, we do not find any point of law of general public importance involved in the decision so as to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, this application is also rejected.

No. 294 of 2013.</p> <p>As per stamp reporter's report, there is delay of 07 months and 22 days in filing the application for leave to appeal. Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 provides that the application for leave to appeal <u>shall</u> be made for approaching Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of decision of the Tribunal. Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for condoning the delay are general in nature and do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another reported in 2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:</p> <p><i>“Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments” and since “the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly binds everybody including the Government.”</i></p>

The Hon'ble Supreme Court further observed as under :

“Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitationThey cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings”.

In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.

M.A. No. 1791 of 2016

This is an application under section 31 (1) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the applicant beyond the period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.

Even otherwise also, we do not find any point of law of general public importance involved in the decision so as to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, this application is also rejected.

In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for condoning the delay are general in nature and do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in <u>Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another</u> reported in <u>2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC</u> in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:</p> <p><i>“Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments” and since “the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly binds everybody including the Government.”</i></p>

The Hon'ble Supreme Court further observed as under :

“Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitationThey cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings”.

In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.

M.A. No. 2317 of 2016

This is an application under section 31 (1) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the applicant beyond the period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.

Even otherwise also, we do not find any point of law of general public importance involved in the decision so as to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, this application is also rejected.

He prayed that respondents be directed to pay family pension including arrears from July 2015.</p> <p>Power filed on behalf of respondents No. 4 & 5 by Shri Vinay Pandey and Shri Sharad Kumar Shukla is on record. It comes out from the pleadings of the parties that some person has objected that applicant is not entitled for family pension resulting, family pension has been stopped by Respondent No 5. On raising objection by the applicant, PCDA (Pension), Allahabad has issued instructions to Respondent No 4 and 5 to grant family pension vide their letter dated 18.08.2015 and on 31.03.2016. In spite of directions issued by PCDA (Pension) Allahabad to pay family pension, the same has not been paid to the applicant.</p> <p>Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 & 5 states that due to certain objections raised by Shri Yashwant Singh, son of late Maj Bharat Singh payment of family pension has been stopped.</p> <p>It is clear that Respondent No. 5 has no right to stop family pension of the applicant and moreover PCDA (Pension) Allahabad has directed Respondent No 4 and 5 to make payment of family pension vide their letter dated 18.08.2015 and 31.03.2016 with respect to pension already credited in the account of the applicant.</p>

There seems to be some serious manipulation on part of Respondent No. 5. Accordingly we direct Chief Manager, Central Bank of India, CPPC, 2nd Floor, MMO Bldg, M.G. Road, Fort Mumbai to hold inquiry against The Manager, Central Bank of India, Civil Lines, Faizabad (UP) that on which ground family pension of the applicant has been stopped. Further we direct Respondent No. 5 to clear dues of the applicant in accordance with law and in accordance with letter issued by PCDA (Pension) Allahabad.

Chief Manager, Central Bank of India, CPPC, 2nd Floor, MMO Bldg, M.G. Road, Fort Mumbai, to inform this Court, as to whether an inquiry has been initiated against Respondent No 5 or not to enquire why payment of family pension to the applicant has been stopped and the outcome of the said inquiry by the next date.
