Counsel for the petitioner invited attention to the attempts made on the life of the petitioner, i.e. <i>Kambal Parade</i> on 13-14.04.1990 at 216 Transit Camp, Srinagar. Capt (Dr.) D Pal, RMO 6 RAJPUT provided treatment to the petitioner at Command Hut, Srinagar. The petitioner was provided Glucose Drip and was given first aid.</p> <p>It is further stated that on 15-20.04.1990, the petitioner was forced to proceed on leave and despatched by Indian Airlines by Capt Amit Hazela and admitted in 7, Air Force Hospital, Kanpur on 18.04.1990 and thereafter on 20.04.1990 he was transferred to Command Hospital, Lucknow where he remained admitted till 05.06.1990.</p> <p>Thereafter between 23.06.1990 and 31.07.1990, the petitioner was admitted in Army Hospital, New Delhi where Dr. Rajendra Singh, Senior Advisor (Psychiatry) had provided treatment to him.</p> <p>On 01.10.1990, the petitioner was admitted in 92, Base Hospital, Shrinagar which was presided by Col ABTK Rao. The petitioner was placed in Medical Category S-3(T-24).</p> <p>The petitioner was placed on "dangerously ill list" between 11.04.1990 to 18.04.1990 at Military Hospital, Srinagar. It is submitted that the applicant was placed in Medical Category S-3 (T-24) for gunshot injury on abdomen for adjustment reaction.</p> <p>It is further submitted that the petitioner was examined at Niyari on 07.06.1991. Court Martial commenced on 07.06.1991 but he was examined by Regimental Medical Officer (RMO) of 4, Rajputana Rifles.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the petitioner emphatically submitted that in spite of</p>

all efforts, the petitioner could not get copies of the medical reports and records indicating treatment provided to the petitioner.

Since assault on petitioner's life co-relates and subsequent treatment provided to him, coupled by letter written by the petitioner's father to the Superintendent of Police, it is necessary to look into the medical reports/treatment provided to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct as under:

(1). Capt (Dr) D Pal, RMO, 6 RAJPUT at Command Hut, who had provided Glucose Drip and First Aid on 13-14.04.1990 to the petitioner is directed to file his personal affidavit with regard to treatment provided to the petitioner and also his observation with regard to petitioner's injury on or before the next date of listing of the case. In case affidavit is not filed, Capt (Dr) D. Pal is directed to appear personally before this Tribunal on said date to assist the Tribunal. In case Capt (Dr) D. Pal has retired, he is commanded to appear before this Tribunal on next date of listing of the case and accordingly he shall be communicated by the respondents.

(2) The petitioner was admitted in 7, Air Force Hospital, Kanpur on 18.04.1990 and then transferred to Command Hospital, Lucknow on 20.04.1990 and remained admitted till 05.06.1990. Let entire records with regard to treatment provided to the petitioner with effect from 18.04.1990 at 7, Air Force Hospital, Kanpur be produced before this Tribunal on the next date. The doctor concerned shall also file affidavit with regard to treatment provided to the petitioner. 7, Air Force Hospital, Kanpur be informed accordingly by the respondents. A medical officer from 7, Air Force Hospital, Kanpur shall appear along with record to assist the Tribunal.

(3) Since the petitioner was admitted in Command Hospital, Lucknow on 20.04.1990 to 05.06.1990, a medical officer from Command Hospital, Lucknow shall appear in person to assist the Tribunal along with entire original record relating to treatment provided to the petitioner. The officer shall explain with regard to treatment provided to the petitioner and shall also explain the reason of discharge of the petitioner from Command Hospital, Lucknow.

(4) Since the petitioner underwent treatment at Army Hospital, New Delhi by Dr. Rajendra Singh, Senior Advisor (Psychiatry) and some other doctors from 23.06.1990 to 31.07.1990, record of the Army Hospital, New Delhi with regard to treatment provided to the petitioner shall be produced and some doctor from said hospital shall appear to assist the Tribunal on the next date of listing with regard to problem of the petitioner and shall explain petitioner's condition to admit him in the hospital for more than a month.

(5) The record of 92, Base Hospital, Shrinagar from 01.10.1990

containing petitioner's admission and treatment provided thereto be produced before the Tribunal on the next date. Col ABTK Rao shall file his personal affidavit with regard to treatment provided to the petitioner. In case he has retired, the record shall be communicated and permitted to go through the records.

(6) All material relying upon which the petitioner was alleged to be placed on "Dangerously Ill List" from 01.04.1090 to 18.04.1990 be produced before this Tribunal on the next date of listing.

(7) The injury report with regard to gunshot injury suffered by the petitioner and treatment provided to him as recorded by 92 Base Hospital, Shrinagar shall also be placed before this Tribunal on the next date of listing.

(8) Regimental Medical Officer, 4 Rajput Regiment who examined the petitioner during course of Court Martial on 07.06.1991 or later on shall file affidavit with regard to mental condition of the petitioner annexing thereto relevant supporting records.

List this case on **27.07.2016** for **further hearing**.

In terms of aforesaid order let records be filed/produced on the next date. It is clarified that it shall be open to respondents to file photo copies of the original medical records regarding treatment given to the petitioner.

Chief of the Army Staff shall ensure filing of affidavits or presence of the officers before this Tribunal as directed above.

Respondents shall file affidavit of compliance on the next date of listing.

On the date fixed, Ld. Counsel for the Respondents shall produce original documents pertaining to case for perusal of the Bench.

Copy of the order be provided to Ld. Counsel for the parties by 25.05.2016 free of cost.
