No. 157 of 2015</u></p> <p>Applicant while under going training in the Army has been discharged on the ground that he is unbecoming and inefficient soldier. Para 4 of the counter affidavit shows that he could not pass the mandatory test like PPT, IPET, Swimming and Basic Foundation Course.</p> <p>Merely saying in the counter affidavit without supporting material seems to be not sufficient. The cause shown by the respondents is vague and does not meet the requirement of law. It is silent as to when and how the applicant failed in different tests and who reported that he is not fit to be retained in service. Neither any notice was served on the applicant nor from the material on record it is born out that the applicant was given some alternative option in accordance with Army Instructions. It is sorry state of affairs on the part of respondents that counter affidavit has been filed in such a casual manner. It is not possible to expedite pending cases on account of such casual approach on part of the respondents.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be sent to the Hon'ble Defence Minister and Defence Secretary by the Registry for making necessary arrangements.</p> <p>At this stage, as prayed by Ld. Counsel for the respondents we grant three weeks'</p>

further time to the respondents to file supplementary counter affidavit and bring entire material on record relating to the present controversy. Ld. Counsel for the applicant shall have two weeks' time thereafter to file supplementary rejoinder affidavit.

Since we have granted indulgence while granting time to respondents to file supplementary counter affidavit, the Registry need not send copy of this order to Hon'ble Defence Minister and Defence Secretary.

M.A. No 1917 of 2015 is disposed of.</p> <p><u>R. A. No. 18 of 2015</u>  In spite of notice sent by Registry none turned up on behalf of respondent-applicant. Office report shows that notice is deemed to be sufficient. Accordingly we proceed to dispose the review application on merit.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant-respondents argued that the respondent-applicant was dismissed from service in Apr 2012. While approaching the Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the respondent-applicant has not disclosed the correct fact regarding dismissal from service. In consequence thereto he was directed to surrender before the appropriate authority while deciding the controversy by order dated 23.10.2013.</p> <p>Specific ground has been taken by applicant-respondents that respondent-applicant has been dismissed from service. The order dated 23.10.2013 has been passed ex-parte without providing opportunity to file counter affidavit. The Tribunal has also not entered into the merits of the controversy. Thus, it appears that order dated 23.10.2013 has been passed without complying the principles of natural justice and without opportunity to defend the cause of applicant-respondents. The error appears to be apparent on the face</p>

of the record.

Accordingly we allow the review application and recall order dated 23.10.2013 and restore the O.A. to its original number.

R.A. No. 18 of 2015 is disposed of.
