Counsel for the applicant that while deciding the representation, the applicant has been discharged without holding Review Medical Board. In view of law settled by the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Kochi the applicant is entitled to continue till 57 years. It is submitted that the respondents are superannuating the applicant today itself.</p> <p>On the other hand Ld. Counsel for the respondents assisted by OIC Legal Cell submits that the applicant has completed ten years of service. On account of Low Medical Category, he is likely to be discharged today itself.</p> <p>A question cropped up whether without holding Review Medical Board, the respondents may decline to grant extension of service keeping in view earlier decisions? Ld. Counsel for the respondents shall receive instructions on the pleadings and materials on record.</p> <p>List on 03.06.2016 as fresh before vacation bench to enable Ld. Counsel for the respondents and OIC Legal Cell to receive instructions.</p> <p>In case no Review Medical Board is necessary before discharging the applicant, appropriate order may be passed on 03.06.2016.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant shall serve copy of the petition on Ld. Counsel for the respondents today itself.</p> <p>Let copy of the order be supplied to Ld.
