While arguing with regard to reliefs claimed in the O.A., it has been submitted by Ld. Counsel for the applicant that the applicant retired while holding the post of Junior Warrant Officer, but he has been paid pension of the rank of Sergeant.

On the other hand, Ld. Counsel for the respondents raised a preliminary objection that in the Pension Regulations (Air Force), a person has to serve minimum for ten months to become eligible for payment of pension of the rank concerned which, according to Ld. Counsel for the respondents, the applicant has not fulfilled. However, Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that the controversy involved in the present case has been settled by the Kochi Bench as well as the Principal Bench of the Armed Forces Tribunal whereby it has been held that an incumbent shall be entitled for pension of the rank from which he has retired.

Keeping in view the arguments advanced and pleadings on record, we **admit** the O.A.

Counter affidavit be filed by respondents within six weeks. Applicant shall have two weeks thereafter to file rejoinder affidavit, if any.

List the case on **26.07.2016** for orders.

In the meantime, in case the controversy has been settled by the Kochi Bench and the Principal Bench of the Armed Forces Tribunal, and the order has attained finality, the respondents shall consider the case of the applicant for payment of pension of the rank of Junior Warrant Officer.
