This Original Application (Appeal) has been filed by the appellant under section 15 of the AFT Act, 2007 to quash and set aside findings dated 19.08.2023 and sentence order dated 20.08.2023 passed by DCM.</p> <p>3. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.</p> <p>4. In this Original Application (Appeal), appellant had moved a bail application before this Tribunal which was heard on merit and was rejected by order dated 09.11.2023 passed by this Tribunal. Thereafter, appellant filed SLP (Criminal) No. 002920/2024 before the Hon'ble Apex Court and by the order dated 08.04.2024, the Hon'ble Apex Court has pleased to direct the release of appellant on bail subject to such terms and conditions to be imposed by the AFT, Lucknow within a period of one week from the date of order. The order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is as below :</p> <p style="text-align: center;">“.....</p> <p>It is also submitted that the main appeal is still to be adjudicated before the Armed Forces Tribunal, Lucknow. In the circumstances, taking note of the peculiar facts of this case, we allow this appeal by setting aside the impugned order and direct release of the appellant on bail subject to such terms and conditions to be imposed by the Armed Forces Tribunal, Lucknow within a period of one week from today.”</p> <p>5. Therefore, in compliance of the order of the Hon'ble Apex Court dated 08.04.2024, the Appellant shall be released on bail forthwith on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty Thousand only) with one surety in the like</p>

amount to the satisfaction of the Registrar of this Tribunal. On furnishing surety, as stated above, Registrar shall then issue the release order, which in turn will be conveyed to the concerned Jail Superintendent, District Jail Tezpur (Assam), wherein the appellant is presently confined and serving out his sentence. The appellant after release on bail shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not cause any hindrance in pending proceedings and shall fully cooperate in peaceful hearing of the appeal. The appellant shall not leave the jurisdiction of this Tribunal without proper permission of the Tribunal. In case any complaint with regard to his conduct during the period of bail is received, the respondents will be free to apply for cancellation of the bail granted by this Tribunal.

6. After release of the appellant, the bail bonds furnished for his release, shall be kept on record of this Original Application.

7. List this case on its already fixed date, i.e. on **09.05.2024** for hearing on appeal.

8. Let a copy of this order be provided to learned counsel for the parties for their necessary action and compliance.
