There is delay of 102 days in filing leave to appeal. Learned counsel for Union of India & Ors has moved application for condonation of delay.</p> <p>4. Submission of learned counsel for the applicants-Union of India & Others is that delay in filing leave to appeal is not deliberate. His further submission is that after passing of the order dated 08.08.2023 sometime has taken place in obtaining instructions from the respondents. Thus, his submission is that delay is not intentional, but for the reasons mentioned above and time taken by the department in processing the case for filing of the present application, delay of 102 days is condonable in filing application for leave to appeal.</p> <p>5. We have gone through the affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application and find that the grounds and reasons shown in the accompanying affidavit for condonation of delay seem sufficient and therefore, delay in filing application is condoned. Delay condonation application stands disposed off.</p> <p><u>LTA No 2182 of 2023</u></p> <p>6. This application has been filed under Section 30 read with Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 against the judgment and order dated 08.08.2023 of this Tribunal passed in T.A.
