On the case being taken up for hearing, ShriSurender Pal Singh Chauhan, ShriAnil DevJamwal, through virtual mode and ShriManoj Kumar Awasthi,Ld. Counsel for appellant and ShriAmitJaiswal, Ld. Counsel for the respondents are present.</div><div>M.A. No. 779 of 2024</div><div>2. This application has been moved on behalf of the appellant under Section 15 (3) of the AFT Act, 2007 and Rule 25 of the AFT (Procedure) Rules, 2008 for suspension of sentence awarded and to release the appellant on bail.</div><div>3. Brief facts of the case are that appellant was commissioned in the Indian Army on 17.09.2005. The appellant while posted at Bareilly was charged with using criminal force to a lady Army Officer of the same unit on 16.06.2022 to outrage her modesty. The appellant was convicted by General Court Martial (GCM) and was sentenced ‘To be Cashiered’ and ‘To suffer Rigorous Imprisonment for one year’ vide order dated 09.05.2024 and the appellant is in jail.</div><div>4. Submission of learned counsel for the appellant is that appellant was convicted and awarded two punishments by GCM, firstly, ‘To be Cashiered’ and secondly, ‘To suffer Rigorous Imprisonment for one year’ vide order dated 09.05.2024. The appellant has already undergone more than half of the punishment against the punishment of 01 year Rigorous Imprisonment. The appellant lost his father during the course of proceedings and his widowedmother is suffering from various ailments and needs constant medical care and attention. The wife of the appellant is a serving Army Officer who is posted in a remote area of North East India and has a school going minor daughter for whom there is no one else to look after. He placed reliance on the</div></div>

	<p>judgment of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case of Major Saurabh Saharan vs. Union of India & Others, WP No. 1755/2013 and Maj Manish Kumar vs. Union of India & Others in Writ Petition No. 7926/2020 and AFT (RB) Guwahati judgment in O.A. (A) No. 22/2023, Subedar (RT) Brijesh Kumar Sharma vs. Union of India & Others, decided on 20.09.2023 and judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Rani Kusum vs. Kanchan Devi & Others, 2005 (6) SCC 705 and pleaded to release the appellant on bail as the appellant has already undergone more than 8 months of imprisonment against the award of 01 year.</p> <p>5. Written objection on bail application has not been filed by the respondents. However, learned counsel for the respondents vehemently opposed the prayer of the bail and submitted that appellant has been convicted in serious offence/heinous crime of sexual harassment with a lady officer of the same unit where the appellant was posted. He further submitted that he is ready to argue the case on merit to dispose the appeal finally.</p> <p>6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.</p> <p>7. In this case, appellant has been convicted and awarded two punishments by GCM; first punishment, 'To be Cashiered' and second punishment, 'To suffer Rigorous Imprisonment for one year' vide order dated 09.05.2024. The first punishment 'To be Cashiered' has already been completed. As regards the second punishment of 01 year Rigorous Imprisonment, it is not disputed by the parties that appellant has been detained in this case for more than 8 months against the punishment of 01 year.</p> <p>8. Original Application filed by the appellant has been admitted by this Tribunal on 17.10.2024 and on request of learned counsel for the parties, time for filing counter and rejoinder has been granted.</p> <p>9. Considering the fact of the case and period of detention, we are of the opinion that it may take time to dispose the appeal on merit, therefore, we are of the view that there is sufficient ground to release the appellant on bail till disposal of this Original Application (Appeal).</p> <p>10. In view of above, the application for bail is allowed. The Appellant shall be released on bail forthwith on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty Thousand only) with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Registrar of this Tribunal. On furnishing surety, as stated above, Registrar shall then issue the release order, which in turn will be conveyed to the concerned Jail Superintendent, Civil Jail, Bareilly (UP) wherein the appellant is presently confined and serving out his sentence. The appellant after release on bail shall attend Armed Forces Tribunal on each and every date of hearing. He shall not indulge in any criminal activity or commission of any crime after being released on bail. He shall surrender his passport (if any) and shall not leave the Country without the prior permission of this Tribunal where his case is pending. The</p>

	<p>appellant shall not cause any hinderance in pending proceedings and shall fully cooperate in peaceful hearing of the appeal. The appellant shall not leave the jurisdiction of this Tribunal without proper permission of the Tribunal. In case any complaint with regard to his conduct during the period of bail is received, the respondents will be free to apply for cancellation of the bail granted by this Tribunal.</p> <p>11. After release of the appellant, the bail bonds furnished for his release, shall be kept on record of this Original Application.</p> <p>12. M.A. No 779 of 2024 stands disposed of accordingly.</p> <p>13. List this case for hearing on Appeal on 19.12.2024.</p> <p>14.
