There is delay of 03 months and 23 days in filing leave to appeal. Learned counsel for Union of India & Others has moved application for condonation of delay.</p> <p>4. Submission of learned counsel for the applicants-Chief of the Army staff & Others is that delay in filing leave to appeal is not deliberate. His further submission is that after passing of the order dated 17.03.2023 in T.A. No 64 of 2016, sometime has taken place in obtaining instructions from the respondents. Thus, his submission is that delay is not intentional, but for the reasons mentioned above and time taken by the department in processing the case for filing of the present application, delay of 03 months and 23 days is condonable in filing application for leave to appeal.</p> <p>5. We have gone through the affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application and find that the grounds and reasons shown in the accompanying affidavit for condonation of delay seem sufficient and therefore, delay in filing application is condoned.
