Counsel for the applicant and Shri Shailendra Sharma Atal, Ld. counsel for the respondents, through virtual mode, are present. In compliance of the order dated 01.04.2024, Objection on delay condonation application as well as maintainability of the Original Application has already been filed by the respondents and is available on record. Objection filed by the respondents is taken on record. Reply to the objection has been filed by the applicant is also taken on record. This Original Application has been filed by the applicant under Section 14 of the AFT Act, 2007 to quash/set aside order dated 22.07.1998 by which Commanding Officer has dismissed to the applicant from service and also to set aside the impugned order dated 17.08.2023 passed by the Chief of the Army Staff affirming the sentence passed by SCM and to grant service pension to the applicant with all consequential benefits taking into consideration 15 years service of the applicant. There is delay of more than 22 years in filing Original Application. The applicant has moved application for condoning the delay. Objection regarding delay and maintainability of the Original Application has been filed by the respondents wherein it is stated that instant application is delayed by more than 22 years and long delay of 22 years has not been properly explained on day to day basis. With regard to maintainability of the Original Application, it is stated that instant Original Application is arising out of a Court Martial proceedings but the applicant has challenged the dismissal order under Section 14 of the AFT Act, 2007 which is not maintainable before the Tribunal lacking jurisdiction and deserves to be dismissed at the admission

stage itself.

7. Learned counsel for the applicant, on the other hand, submitted that during course of proceedings for Summary Court Martial (SCM), Commanding Officer not provided the copy of SCM proceedings to the applicant nor after passing the sentence of dismissal. Hence, applicant moved a representation dated 13.12.1999 before the Commanding Officer which was not considered. When no action was taken on the representation dated 13.12.1999, applicant moved another representation before the Commanding Officer and copy of SCM proceedings were provided to the applicant vide 268 Engineer Regiment letter dated 18.03.2000. After receipt of SCM proceedings, the applicant moved another application dated 21.06.2002 asking discharge certificate as well as recording of Summary of Evidence to file a case before the court but no action was taken by the Commanding Officer to provide the documents, hence, applicant approached the respondents by filing representations dated 19.09.2005 and 23.08.2009 but no reply was given to the applicant. Thereafter, applicant processed his case asking documents of SCM proceedings through RTI vide application dated 30.05.2018 and then it was replied by OIC Records, Bombay Engineer Group vide letter dated 02.08.2018 that SCM proceedings has already been destroyed by burning in terms of Para 592 of Regulations for the Army 1987 (Revised). In pursuance to reply dated 02.08.2018, applicant filed appeal dated 14.10.2020 before the Chief of the Army Staff which was kept pending and on receipt of no reply, applicant filed O.A. No. 296 of 2021 before this Tribunal which was disposed of vide order dated 02.07.2021 with direction to the respondents to decide the appeal of the applicant within four months. The appeal of the applicant was rejected by the authority concerned on 17.08.2023 and thereafter, present Original Application has been filed before this Tribunal. He further submitted that delay caused in filing of Original Application is not deliberate and intentional but on account of reasons stated in affidavit mainly due to communication gap of the respondent authorities in providing documents. It was also submitted that Original Application is maintainable having jurisdiction before this Tribunal.

8. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

9. Service matters in relation to persons subject to Army Act, 1950, Navy Act, 1957 and Air Force Act, 1950 have been defined in Section 3(o) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. The case of the applicant filed under Section 14 of the AFT Act, 2007 is covered in Section 3 (o)(iv) under clause, Any other matter, whatsoever, but shall not include matters relating *to sub section (iv)* **‘Summary Court Martial except where the punishment is of dismissal or imprisonment for more than three months’**. Since, the punishment of dismissal by SCM is covered under Section 3 (o) (iv), therefore, this Original Application is maintainable.

10. There is delay of more than 22 years in filing Original Application.
11. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that delay caused in filing of Original Application is not deliberate, but on account of reasons stated in affidavit filed in support of application.
12. We are of the view that grounds shown in affidavit filed in support of application as mentioned in Para 7 above are sufficient. Delay condonation application is allowed and delay in filing application is condoned. Delay condonation application stands disposed of.
13. We are also of the view that under the provisions of Section 3 (o) (iv) of AFT Act, 2007punishment of dismissal by SCM is covered therefore, this Original Application is maintainable before the Tribunal.

14. This Original Application has been filed to quash/set aside order of dismissal and to grant pensionary benefits to the applicant.
15. Matter needs adjudication.
16. Admit.
