In the said application, Smt Devki Devi also stated that Smt Leela Devi and Smt Devki Devi is one and the same person.</div></div><div><div>5.</div><div>Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that Govt of Uttarakhand had issued Uttarjivi Praman Patr on 14.06.2019 stating therein that Smt Leela Devi and Deepak Prasad (Applicant) are survivors of the deceased soldier. Thereafter, vide letter dated 25.06.2019, Smt Leela Devi (wife of the deceased soldier) approached respondent No 3 for grant of family pension to which she was advised to submit certain papers for publication of Part-II Order as her name is not recorded in service documents of the deceased soldier, which she submitted. In the meantime, on 07.06.2020 Smt Leela Devi died.</div></div><div><div>6.</div><div>Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that after death of his mother the applicant on 15.11.2021 sought information through RTI and in response respondent No 3 vide letter dated 27.01.2022 asked nine documents duly verified by concerned Zila Sainik Board. Thereafter, on 26.04.2024 applicant approached Zila Sainik Kalyan Evam Punarvas Adhikari, Pithoragarh and forwarded requisite documents, but despite all efforts, documents related</div></div></div>

	<p>to Life Time Arrear could not be submitted to respondent No. 3.</p> <p>7. Submission of learned counsel for the applicant is that the applicant has been consistently approaching the respondents for grant of Life Time Arrear, therefore delay in filing Original Application is not deliberate, but on account of reasons stated in affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application.</p> <p>8.
