Learned counsel for the respondents submits that first appeal preferred by the applicant on 15.05.2023 was forwarded to Bengal Engineer Group Records, C/o 56 APO vide letter dated 23.05.2023 and this O.A. being filed on 25.08.2023 is premature as it has been filed prior to completion of six months from the date of filing of first appeal. In rebuttal, learned counsel for the applicant submits that O.A. is maintainable as claim for grant of special family pension was rejected vide order dated 22.12.2022. After hearing both the sides it is apparent that approx nine months have passed after filing first appeal which is still pending, we are of the view that it will not be fruitful to return this O.A. at this stage.
