PPO was issued and the applicant was paid pension. However, from January 2006, his pension was stopped on the ground as admitted in the counter affidavit that under Pension Regulations for the Army-1961 (Part-I), in the event of involvement of any criminal case, the retiree shall not be entitled for regular pension and only provisional pension may be paid. Vide order dated 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017, we have made query as to whether the Pension Regulations for the Army 1961 (Part-I) has the approval of the Parliament or not. No instruction has been received by the learned counsel for the respondents. Section 192 of the Army Act, 1950 empowers the Central Government to make regulations. Section 193 of the Army Act, 1950 provides that all rules and regulations shall be published in the Official Gazettee and Section 193A of the Army Act, 1950 provides that every rule and every regulation made by the Central Government under this Act shall be laid before the Parliament. For convenience, Sections 192, 193 and 193A of the Arms Act, 1950 are reproduced as under :</p> <p><b><i>"192. Power to make regulations -The Central Government may make regulations for all or any of the purposes of this Act other than those specified, in section <a href="#">191</a>.</i></b></p> <p><b><i>193. Publication of rules and regulations in Gazette. —</i></b> <i>All rules and regulations made under this Act, shall be published in the Official Gazette and, on such publication, shall have effect as if enacted in this Act.</i></p>

**193A. Rules and Regulations to be laid before Parliament-**

*Every rule and every regulation made by the Central Government under this Act shall be laid, as soon as may be after it is made, before each House of Parliament while it is in session, for a total period of thirty days which may be comprised in one session or in two or more successive sessions, and if, before the expiry of the session immediately following the session, or the successive sessions aforesaid, both Houses agree in making any modification in the rule or regulation shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be so, however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that rule or regulation”*

In view of above, we restrain the respondents from stopping the applicant’s regular pension, which has already been paid till further order of the Tribunal. In case the provisions as contained in Sections 192, 193 and 193A of the Army Rules, 1950 has not been complied with, the respondents shall file supplementary counter affidavit and bring on record the status of Pension Regulations for Army as to whether it has been framed in accordance with the provisions contained in Sections 192, 193 and 193A of the Army Act, 1950 within four weeks.

Applicant may file supplementary rejoinder affidavit within four weeks thereafter.

Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for grant of leave to appeal do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in <b>Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another</b> reported in <b>2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC</b> in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:</p> <p><i>“Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments” and since “the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology</i></p>

*of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly binds everybody including the Government.”*

The Hon’ble Supreme Court further observed as under :

*“Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitation .....They cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings”.*

In view of the decision of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.
