The matter relates to family pension to the Naval personnel.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that in spite of best efforts, the respondents and the concerned authorities are not taking interest and instructions have not been provided to him for arguing the case before the Tribunal.</p> <p>A perusal of the record shows that more than a year has elapsed but counter affidavit has not been filed by the respondents. It further transpires from the record that on 16 March 2016, this Tribunal had afforded last opportunity to the respondents to file counter affidavit. Yet again on 22 November 2016, four weeks' further time was granted to the respondents to file counter affidavit.</p> <p>It is unfortunate that in spite of indulgence granted by the Tribunal, no counter affidavit is forthcoming on behalf of the respondents. This conduct of the respondents and its concerned authorities shows the casual and careless approach of the respondents with regard to cases pending in this Tribunal.</p> <p>In these circumstances, we are constrained to direct the respondents to positively file counter affidavit by the next date fixed in the case failing which the respondents may be saddled</p>

with costs of Rs. 10,000/-. It is further clarified that in case counter affidavit is not filed by the respondents by the next date fixed in the case, Judge Advocate General of the Navy shall appear before the Tribunal to explain as to why counter affidavit has not been filed in the case.

List the case on **15.12.2017** for further orders.

Registry shall communicate this order to the authority concerned including the Judge Advocate General of the Navy.

Copy of the order be supplied to learned counsel for the respondents free of costs within forty eight hours.
