Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant and Shri Namit Sharma, learned counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant was granted disability pension upto 31.12.2003, however the applicant continued to get disability pension and it was discontinued with effect from 22.11.2010 on the ground that Re-survey Medical Board held in December 2003 had assessed the disability less than 20%.</p> <p>Rejection of disability pension on the ground of less than 20% does not make any difference for payment of disability pension in view of the judgment of Hon'ble The Apex Court in the case of Sukhhvinder Singh Vs. Union of India, reported in (2014) STPL (WEB) 468 SC.</p> <p>Let specific reply be filed by the respondents within four weeks as to why and under what circumstances the disability pension of the applicant has been discontinued, as also the details of Medical Board held since his discharge alongwith recommendation of the Board.
