On 30.04.2004, the applicant’s disability claim was submitted to PCDA (P), Allahabad (respondent no.5) by the respondent no.4, but the same was rejected by the respondent no.5 vide order dated 18.04.2004.

Being aggrieved by the rejection order dated 18.04.2004, the applicant preferred First Appeal on 2nd July 2015 before the Chairman, Appellate Committee on First Appeals (Through EME Records), which is still pending.

Heard Shri RN Singh and Shri Bhanu Pratap Singh, learned counsel for the applicant, Shri Arun Kumar Sahu, learned counsel for the respondents and perused the record.
