He was re-enrolled in DSC in 02.05.1953 and was discharged from there w.e.f. 12.02.1961 on attaining the age of superannuation. In aggregate, Late Sant Bux Singh completed the qualifying service of 13 years and 362 days only, as such, he was not eligible for grant of service pension under the provisions of para 271 of Pension Regulations for the Army 1961 (Part-1). Shri Sant Bux Singh expired on 16.05.1978.</p> <p>The applicant filed Suit no.88 of 1979 for declaration that his father Ex Sep (Late) Sant Bux Singh having rendered service for more than 15 years. The aforesaid suit was dismissed ex parte by the Munsif Sadar, Faizabad vide judgment dated 21.01.1982. Subsequently, the applicant preferred Civil Appeal No.125 of 1982 before the III Addl. District Judge, Faizabad, who vide order</p>

dated 31.03.1984 allowed the appeal observing that Late Sant Bux Singh having rendered service for a period of more than 15 years, is entitled to receive service pension w.e.f. 13.02.1961 till his death on 16.5.1978.

Thereafter, the applicant filed Execution Case no.6 of 1985 in the Court of Munsif Sadar, Faizabad, which was decreed on 02.04.1988, against which, an appeal was preferred by the respondents, which was also dismissed on 21.08.1990. The respondents thereafter preferred a Civil Revision against the order dated 21.08.1990 before the Addl. District Judge, Faizabad, which was allowed vide judgment dated 06.10.1994 and the order passed by the court below was set aside.

It is pertinent to mention here that the applicant without challenging the said judgment, preferred the instant Original Application for payment of service pension.

Since the Civil Revision preferred by the respondents has been allowed by the competent Civil Court, we are of the view that the father of the applicant is not entitled to any service pension till the revisional order exists.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that since the revisional order has been passed exparte, hence it is not binding upon him. Once the order passed by the competent Civil Court exists, then unless it is modified by the appropriate forum or by the same Court, no pensionary benefits can be given to the father of the applicant till the order passed by the Civil Court exists, even if he is entitled for the same.

In view of the discussions, made hereinabove, the Original Application seems to be not maintainable and is hereby **dismissed**. However, liberty is given to the applicant to approach the appropriate forum to challenge the judgment passed by the Civil Court.

There shall be no order as to costs.
