He submits that writ petition has been filed before the Hon'ble High Court against order of this Tribunal, which is listed for hearing.</p> <p>6. Order under implementation was passed on 16.09.2021 and respondents were directed to grant ordinary family pension to the applicant from 21.05.2002 to 02.06.2008 alongwith arrears. More than three and half years have elapsed after passing the order but compliance affidavit has not been filed by the respondents.</p> <p>7. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that writ petition has been filed against order of this Tribunal, which is listed today for hearing.</p>

8. There is no definite period of disposal of writ petition filed by the respondents. There is no stay order by Hon'ble High Court. In view of the above, respondents are duty bound to implement the courts order conditionally subject to final outcome of the writ petition, otherwise delay would come in the purview of intentional disobedience and causing interruption in implementation of order of this Tribunal.
9. Respondents are directed to comply the order subject to final outcome of the writ petition or bring stay order, if any, passed by the Hon'ble High Court.
10. Respondents are further directed to deposit all the cost due against them till next date of listing. Respondents shall file affidavit of compliance within six weeks, failing which they shall show cause as to why notice for initiating proceedings under Section 19 of the AFT Act, 2007 and Rule 25 of AFT (Procedure) Rules-2008 be not issued against them.
11. Copy of this order be provided to learned counsel for the respondents/OIC Legal Cell. Copy of this order shall also be sent to ADG (PS) and Secretary, Ministry of Defence DESW for information and necessary action.
