It is not for the Court to interfere in the matter which is based on discretionary power of the army officers.' Though the Commanding Officer has directed for extension of service. However it is not disputed that the order has been passed by the competent authority of the army.</p> <p>From perusal of the judgment and order it appears that the applicant approached the Tribunal after lapse of about 12 years in consequence thereof it is not fit case to interfere in the matter. On the face of record, there is no error.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that it was noted by the</p>

Tribunal that the Commanding Officer has recommended the applicant for retention in service. There appears error on the face of record which may require correction of the impugned order instead of reviewing the same since the final out come of the case in letter and sprit of the judgment would remain the same.

In view of the observation made by Ld. Counsel for the applicant, we correct the judgment and order as word 'discharge' is substituted by the word 'retention'. The whole line may be read as under:

Counsels for the respondents.</p> <p><u>Application for condonation of delay in filing review application</u></p> <p>This is an application for condonation of delay in filing Review Application in pursuance to provisions contained under Section 14 (f) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 read with Rule 18 of the Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules 2008.</p> <p>According to Ld. Counsel for the applicant, the applicant is a necessary as well as proper party, but while approaching the Tribunal, the private respondent has not impleaded him while preferring O.A. No. 255 of 2012 which has been decided by order dated 30.10.2012.</p> <p>While pressing for application for condonation of delay, Ld. Counsel for the applicant invited attention to averments contained in the application, according to which, the applicant learnt with regard to impugned judgment/order of the Tribunal after issuance of schedule of Selection Board dated 17.08.2015. His submission is that only after 17.08.2015 he came to know that the applicant succeeded with regard to consideration of seniority for the purpose of promotion to the rank of Lt. General by the Special</p>

Selection Board (SSB) scheduled in 2015. His submission is that when applicant gained knowledge with regard to the impugned order after obtaining certified copy of the order dated 30.10.2013 the applicant preferred Review Application along with application for condonation of delay. The Review Application was filed before the Tribunal on 15.10.2015.

On the other hand, Sri T. Prashad, Ld. Counsel for the private respondent invited attention to paragraphs 18, 19 and 20 of the reply and submitted that the applicant was well aware with the delivery of the judgment/order by the Tribunal and he has failed to make out sufficient cause for the propose of condonation of delay. He further submitted that it was on 20.06.2012 when the private respondents case was considered on the basis of Annual Confidential Report for the year 2009 and 2010. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the applicant that the result of the applicant was de-classified and approved for promotion with the batch of Army Ordnance Corps Officers to acting rank of Major General in Army Ordnance Corps. Further submission of the Ld. Counsel for the respondents is that on 30.10.2012 the Armed Forces Tribunal delivered judgment/order. It is also submitted that the Union of India had filed Review Application which was dismissed on 15.01.2013. Further submission of Ld. Counsel for the private respondent is that M.S. Branch on 05.04.2013 placed on its website issues agenda for SB -1 to be held on 12th and 13th April, 2013 in which applicant's name was also considered as case of 1979 batch of Army Ordnance Corps. This fact has been rebutted by Ld. Counsel for the applicant. Further Ld. Counsel for the private respondent invited attention with regard to tentative list of Army Ordnance Corps Officers of 1979 Batch to be considered by SSB for promotion to the rank of Lt. General issued by the MS. Branch (X). On 26.08.2015 final list of Army Ordnance Corps Officers of 1979 Batch was issued to be considered by SSB for promotion to the rank of Lt. General. Further submission of Ld. Counsel for the private respondent is that at different stages cases were looked by the Ministry of Defence for different persons which

was well within the knowledge of the applicant. Shri Sunil Sharma, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that the Union of India had filed Review Application which was well within the knowledge of the applicant.

Another startling fact has been brought up by Ld. Counsel for the respondents from his own records is that judgment/order of this Tribunal dated 30.10.2012 was faxed on 31.10.2012 which was obtained by the applicant. In case the argument of Ld. Counsel for the private respondent is considered as correct, then there appears no room of doubt that the applicant was not aware of the impugned order dated 30.10.2012. However, fact seems to be otherwise. We take on record the photo state copy of the certified copy of the impugned order of the Tribunal, which according to Ld. Counsel for the private respondent was sent through FAX. While considering this aspect of the matter we take note of the fact that the final order of the Tribunal is dated 30.10.2012 and it seems to be faxed on 31.10.2012, i.e. the very next day from the date of delivery of judgment/order. Certified copy of the judgment/order was prepared by the Registry of the Tribunal on 31.10.2012 itself. Then, how the applicant would have been present at Lucknow to obtain certified copy of the judgment/order and send it through FAX to the private respondent or his counsel is not borne out. In normal circumstances, certified copies are obtained by litigants or their counsel. Submission made by private respondent seems not to be trustworthy and is misconceived. How and under what circumstances, photo state copy of the certified copy of the judgment/order of this Tribunal dated 30.12.2012 alleged to be faxed on 31.10.2012 has come into the hands of private respondent is not borne from the record and in the absence of any specific pleading there is no reason to accept the argument of private respondent. It may further be noted that certified copy filed by the applicant and placed on record while filing Review Application was prepared by the Registry on 31.10.2015. Once the applicant had received certified copy of the judgment/order, then there appears no reason to

provide the respondent's counsel photo state copy of certified copy which dated back to 31.10.2012, i.e. immediately on the next date when the judgment/order was delivered.

Submission made by Ld. Counsel for the private respondent not only is untrustworthy but seems to be a cooked up case as is apparent from the face of the record.

Entire argument raised by Ld. Counsel for the private respondent and Shri Sunil Sharma, Ld. Counsel for the respondents is based on presumptions and suppositions. Merely because certain departmental proceedings were held with regard to promotional avenue, it does not mean that the applicant was knowing with regard to the judgment/order of the Tribunal unless some record is produced before the Tribunal which may indicate that the judgment/order of the Tribunal was known to the applicant. In these circumstances, on presumptions and suppositions, argument by Ld. Counsel for the private respondent cannot be basis to oppose the application for condonation of delay.

It may be noticed that in the present case, the applicant was not impleaded as respondent while preferring the O.A. Shri Sunil Sharma, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that while preferring the Review Application, it was pleaded that Major General P.V.K. Menon, respondent no. 4 in the O.A. has suffered set back on account of the impugned order. However, in case the applicant suffered adversely on account of effect of the impugned judgment/order, and he came to know regarding impugned order of this Tribunal on or after 17.08.2015, then there appears no reason to deprive the applicant to contest the case on merit.

It is well settled proposition of law that doors of the courts should not be closed with regard to controversy which may effect the fundamental rights of the citizens. While condoning delay, the approach of the Courts and Tribunals should be liberal so that no one suffers in this justice oriented system. Purpose of the Tribunal is to impart justice and not to do injustice. Otherwise also, when two views are possible, then the view which is pro-

justice should accepted.

In the present case, we are of the view that the application for condonation of delay should be allowed so that the controversy in question may be considered on merits, that too when the applicant was not a party in the original O.A.

Accordingly, in view of the well settled proposition of law the delay in filing the Review Application should be considered liberally and the application should be allowed.

Accordingly, the application for condonation of delay is allowed and delay in filing Review Application is condoned.

Keeping in view the fact that the applicant was not impleaded as respondent in the original O.A. we **admit** the Review Application and permit the respondents to file counter affidavit a period of three weeks. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.

List the case on 03.02.2016

Keeping in view the fact that prima facie the applicant was not party in the original O.A., we provide that in case any promotion shall be made it shall be tentative one and shall be subject to final orders passed by this Tribunal.

At this stage Ld. Counsel for the parties submitted that they are prepared with the arguments and the case may be listed on an earlier date. Accordingly, we prepone date of hearing.

List the case on **25.01.2016** for peremptory hearing.

On the date fixed, Ld. Counsel for the Respondents shall produce original documents pertaining to case for perusal of the Bench.

Ld. Counsel for the parties may submit/exchange synopsis/written arguments, supported with law, if any by the date fixed.
