Counsel for the respondents and perused the record.</p> <p>Brief fact giving rise this M.A. No. 1056 of 2022 is that applicant has moved O.A. No. 358 of 2022 with prayer to direct opposite parties to grant family pension to the applicant w.e.f. the missing of her husband i.e. 01.11.1992. As reported by registry O.A. has been moved with a delay of 27 years and 12 days. For condoning the delay applicant has moved M.A. No. 408 of 2022. At the time of hearing on delay condonation application and admission of the O.A., memo of appearance of Dr. Shailendra Sharma Atal for respondents has been filed and taken on record. Before passing any order on delay condonation application and admission, on 13.07.2022 the Bench observed that dismissal of her husband has not been challenged by the applicant and directed the applicant to amend prayer clause of the O.A. and to take within week. In compliance of that order this M.A. No. 1056 of 2022 has been moved by the applicant.</p> <p>In objection moved by the Opposite Party on amendment application, it is mainly stated that amendment sought is time barred and the applicant has not pleaded a single word to justify the delay caused in moving the application. It is further stated that even a single fresh ground has not been adduced in amendment application for assailing the dismissal order and the proposed amendment will constitute altogether separate cause of action.</p> <p>We have considered the submissions of Ld. counsel for the parties and facts and circumstances of the case.</p>

The amendment application has been moved in compliance of the order of the Bench dated 13.07.2022. So far as objections of maintainability and being time barred, as raised by the respondents are concerned, the delay condonation application (M.A. No. 408 of 2022) and on admissibility of O.A. are still to be heard and at that time it will be open for the respondents to raise the objection. At this stage there is sufficient ground to allow the amendment application which is liable to be allowed. Accordingly amendment application is allowed. The amendment to be incorporated within a week. M.A. No. 1056 of 2022 is disposed off.
