It is surprising that no doubt the applicant has preferred this writ petition/T.A. with the prayer for quashing of SCM proceedings but the same has not been annexed along with this writ petition. The applicant is, therefore, directed to bring on record, by means of an affidavit, the SCM proceedings, the copy of which must have been supplied to the applicant, within a period of two weeks.

Further the submission of the applicant is that the SCM proceedings and Summary of Evidence are false and frivolous and, as such, the punishment awarded to the applicant is also non est. He has also drawn our attention on Annexure 'P-15', the medical examination report to indicate that he was tortured during SCM proceedings while in custody of the opposite party. Further he has also taken up to the judgment of the Hon'ble M.P. High Court, passed in the aforesaid Habeas Corpus Writ Petition, and the observations given therein.

There seems to be some substance in the argument of the applicant. Accordingly, we **admit** this T.A.
