Ridhishri Sharma, Departmental Representative.</p> <p>Heard learned counsel for the parties regarding maintainability of this O.A. as also on admission of this O.A.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant, regarding maintainability of this O.A. submits that under Section 3(o)(iv) of the A.F.T. Act, 2007 provides 'any other matter, whatsoever,' is service matter and as such this O.A. is maintainable before this Tribunal since this matter pertains with respect to outcome of service.</p> <p>We are also, prima facie, of the view that as per Section 3(o)(iv) of the Act, this O.A. is maintainable before this Tribunal.</p> <p>On admission of this O.A., learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant after being proceeded with SCM on the charges made under Sections 41(1), 40(c ) and 63 of the Army Act was awarded punishment in the shape of 'reduction in rank' and 'R.I. for 75 days'. Act, 2007 since it is the outcome of summary disposal and Section 3(o)(iii) of the Act provides that only those summary disposal cases are to be treated as service matters for the purpose of this Act where punishment of dismissal is awarded. Therefore, according to learned counsel for the respondents, this T.A. is not maintainable before this Tribunal.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner, while arguing this case, brought to the notice of this Court the judgment dated 20.2.2014 passed by a Division Bench of the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court in Writ Petition No. 8051 (S/B) of 1989 and to impress upon this Court that the Hon'ble High Court has dealt with the issue and came to the conclusion that the matter of 'severe reprimand' to defence personnel is maintainable before this Tribunal. While going through the aforesaid judgment of the Hon'ble High Court we find that the Hon'ble High Court has observed in paragraph 12 of that judgment that "<i>Legislature to their wisdom has included all matters which correlate to service matters or incident of service of the army personnel except the exception provided in the Act itself.</i>"</p> <p>Whereas, the Hon'ble apex Court in Civil Appeal No. 7400 of 2013 dealt with the case of Armed Forces Tribunal and came to the conclusion that "<i>High Court will not entertain a petition under Article 226 of the</i></p>

*Constitution if an effective alternative remedy is available to the aggrieved person or the statute under which the action complained of has been taken itself contains a mechanism for redressal of grievance still holds the field.”*

Further the Hon’ble Supreme Court in paragraph 30 further had gone to the extent in saying that *“It is a settled canon of law that the High Court would not normally interfere in exercise of its jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India where statutory alternative remedy is available.”*

The argument of learned counsel for the applicant is that since Hon’ble Lucknow Bench of the Allahabad High Court on 20.2.2014 in Writ Petition No.8051 of 1989 (*supra*) had indicated that the question of ‘severe reprimand’ falls within the service matters from which an employee is effected, A.F.T. is competent to entertain the same as being service matter irrespective of the fact that there is a rider under Section 3(o)(iii) of the A.F.T. Act, 2007.

However, the controversy is arguable in nature and can be looked into at the time of hearing of this case. Today this case is listed for admission. Accordingly, we **admit** this T.A.

Learned counsel for the respondents prays for and is granted six weeks’ time to file counter affidavit. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within three weeks thereafter.
