He further submits that after being discharged from Army applicant joined Defence Security Corps (DSC) on 30.08.1993 and discharged on 31.08.2003 due to being in Low Medical Category.</p> <p>The applicant has filed this Original Application for the grant of disability pension in respect of DSC service.</p> <p>There being a of 16 years, 06 months and 13 days in filing of Original Application he has filed an application for condonation of delay which is supported with affidavit.</p> <p>Regarding delay, Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that bar of limitation is not applicable in pensionary matter. He further submits that delay in filing Original Application is not deliberate.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer on the ground that delay of more than 16 years has not been properly and satisfactorily explained.</p> <p>Upon hearing sub missions of Ld. Counsel of both sides we find that law of limitation is not applicable in pensionary matters. We further find that cause shown for the delay is sufficient.</p> <p>Accordingly, delay is condoned.
