	 Submission of Ld. Counsel for the applicant is that delay in filing Review Application is not deliberate. His further submission is that when the applicant came to know about the dismissal of the Original Application he approached the present Counsel to file the Review Application. Thus, his submission is that delay is not deliberate, but for the reasons stated in affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application. In reply, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that there is a delay of more than one year in filing Review Application which has not been properly explained by the applicant on day-to-day basis. Hence, Review Application is liable to be dismissed being time barred. He further submitted that it is settled law that the scope of review jurisdiction is limited and re-hearing is not permissible as the judgment was passed in proper perspective after considering all facts and circumstances of the case. Hence, Review Application is liable to be dismissed.

8. Having heard the submission of Ld. Counsel for the parties and
considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that explanation
offered by the applicant for delay in filing Review Application is not sufficient. It
is settled in law that if time limit is given for filing of any application and the
same is not filed within that time limit, delay should be explained on day to day
basis which applicant has utterly failed in the present case.
9. In the result, we find that delay is not condonable.
10. Accordingly, delay condonation application is dismissed .
11. Review Application being time barred is also dismissed .
