Her name shall be shown in the cause list.</p> <p>On the case being taken up for hearing, Shri Vinay Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant and Mrs Anju Singh, learned counsel for the respondents are present.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondents made an oral prayer and submitted that O.A. has no jurisdiction as the applicant is a resident of District-Satna (Madhya Pradesh).</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that since applicant's Record Office is located at Fatehgarh and cause of action has arisen at Record Office, Fatehgarh, which is well within the jurisdiction of this Tribunal, this O.A. has jurisdiction.</p> <p>We have heard learned counsel for the parties and we find that this O.A. has jurisdiction in view of Rule 6 (ii) of the Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2008.</p> <p>In view of the above, objection regarding jurisdiction raised by learned counsel for the respondents is rejected.</p> <p><u>M.A. No. 35 of 2023</u></p> <p>This is an application for condonation of delay in filing Original Application. As per office report, there is delay of 04 months in filing Original Application.</p> <p>Heard Shri Vinay Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant and Mrs Anju Singh, learned counsel for the respondents on delay condonation application.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant submits that delay is not deliberate. He further submits that being a pensionary matter, delay may be condoned.</p> <p>On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents opposed the prayer and submitted that delay has not been properly explained.</p>

Cause shown is sufficient and supported by affidavit.

Accordingly, delay is condoned.

M.A. No. 35 of 2023 is disposed off.
